




# "BE READY FOR 100FOLD"

### Mathew 13:8-9

"Jesus said, <sup>8</sup>Still other seed fell on good soil and produced a crop—a hundredfold, sixtyfold, or thirtyfold. **9**He who has ears, let him hear."

### Mathew 13:1-12

**1**That same day Jesus went out of the house and sat by the sea. **2**Such large crowds gathered around Him that He got into a boat and sat down, while all the people stood on the shore.

**3**And He told them many things in parables, saying, "A farmer went out to sow his seed. **4**And as he was sowing, some seed fell along the path, and the birds came and devoured it.

5Some fell on rocky ground, where it did not have much soil. It sprang up quickly because the soil was shallow. 6But when the sun rose, the seedlings were scorched, and they withered because they had no root.
7Other seed fell among thorns, which grew up and choked the seedlings.
8Still other seed fell on good soil and produced a crop—a hundredfold, sixtyfold, or thirtyfold. 9He who has ears, let him hear."




<sup>10</sup>Then the disciples came to Jesus and asked, "Why do You speak to the people in parables?"

<sup>11</sup>He replied, "The knowledge of the mysteries of the kingdom of heaven has been given to you, but not to them. <sup>12</sup>Whoever has will be given more, and he will have an abundance. Whoever does not have, even what he has will be taken away from him. <sup>13</sup>This is why I speak to them in parables. Vs 24-30

Also, the kingdom of heaven is like a man who sowed good seed in his field. <sup>25</sup>But while everyone was asleep, his enemy came and sowed weeds among the wheat, and slipped away. <sup>27</sup>The owner's servants came to him and said, 'Sir, **28**'So, 'Do you want us to go and pull them up?' <sup>29</sup>'No,' he said, 'if you pull the weeds now, you might uproot the wheat with them. <sup>30</sup>Let both grow together until the harvest. At that time I will tell the harvesters: First collect the weeds and tie them in bundles to be burned; then gather the wheat into my barn.' "

**Brethren**, this is where we see a big risk if we do not run a 100FOLD race. People who do not run a 100fold race have allowed weeds into their field while they slept. Depending on how much damage is done before they



### wake up, they finish at less levels than 100fold. In 1 Corinthians 3: 10-16, Paul said,

<sup>10</sup>By the grace God has given me, I laid a foundation as an expert builder, and someone else is building on it. But each one must be careful how he builds. <sup>11</sup>For no one can lay a foundation other than the one already laid, which is Jesus Christ.

<sup>12</sup>If anyone builds on this foundation using gold, silver, precious stones, wood, hay, or straw, <sup>13</sup>his workmanship will be evident, because the Day will bring it to light. It will be revealed with fire, and the fire will prove the quality of each man's work. <sup>14</sup>If what he has built survives, he will receive a reward. <sup>15</sup>If it is burned up, he will suffer loss. He himself will be saved, but only as if through the flames.

### In Jeremiah 23:29, God said:

"Is not my word like as a fire? And like a hammer that breaks the rock in pieces?"

### 1 John 4:1

**1**Beloved, do not believe every spirit, (**Don't wait for the end of time**) but test the spirits to see whether they are from God. For many false prophets have gone out into the world. **2**By this you will know the Spirit of God: Every spirit that confesses that Jesus Christ has come in the flesh is from God.

### Matthew 7:15

Beware of false prophets. They come to you in sheep's clothing, but inwardly they are ravenous (extremely hungry.) wolves.

#### John 10:10 cautions us to beware because,

<sup>10</sup> The thief comes only to steal and kill and destroy.

25Everyone who competes in the games trains with strict discipline."




### In Gen 26, bible says:

**1**Now there was a famine in the land—besides the previous famine in Abraham's time....<sup>12</sup> Isaac planted crops in that land and the same year reaped a hundredfold, because the LORD blessed him. <sup>13</sup> The man became rich, and his wealth continued to grow until he became very wealthy. <sup>14</sup> He had so many flocks and herds and servants that the Philistines envied him.

### Brethren, can we imagine the Resistance that Isaac would had to contend with in order to obey the word of God?

1. There was famine and people were fleeing the land. ---- staying back, people would think he was foolish

2. The land is dry and God said He will give him the dry land? Who wants a dry land? Everyone needs a green land



3. Can God really do all these things He is promising?


<sup>2</sup> The LORD appeared to Isaac and said, "Do not go down to Egypt; live in the land where I tell you to live. <sup>3</sup> Stay in this land for a while, and I will be with you and will bless you. For to you and your descendants I will give all these lands and will confirm the oath I swore to your father Abraham. <sup>4</sup> I will make your descendants as numerous as the stars in the sky and will give them all these lands, and through your offspring<sup>[a]</sup> all nations on earth will be blessed, <sup>[b] 5</sup> because Abraham obeyed me and did everything I required of him, keeping my commands, my decrees and my instructions." <sup>6</sup> So Isaac stayed in Gerar.

It sound like what we read in the bible now that we, even as Christians, are strongly to believe. Yet, Isaac believed God and stayed.

4. Many advisers would have come to Isaac to desuade him 1 John 4:1 says:

**1**Beloved, do not believe every spirit, but test the spirits to see whether they are from God. For many false prophets have gone out into the world.

### Brethren, to be Ready for 100Folds



- 2. Test the voice we hear against the word of God be sure they are of God
- 3. Do not live by sight BUT by what God has told you
- 4. Inquire from God what you should do in every situation
- 5. Study to understand the word of God and meditate on the word of God
- 6. Obey the word of God through the guidance of the Holy Spirit
- 7. Resist the devil and he will flee from you (James 4:7)
