




2 CORINTHIANS 3:18

Chronicles 16:9

"For the eyes of the LORD roam to and fro over all the earth, to show Himself strong on behalf of those whose hearts are fully devoted to Him.

Romans 8: 11

"If the Spirit of Him who raised Jesus from the dead is living in you, He who raised Christ from the dead will also give life to your mortal bodies because of His Spirit who lives in you."

He listens to every conversation....

Example, In Matthew 27,

⁵⁹ Joseph took the body of Jesus, wrapped it in a clean linen cloth, ⁶⁰ and placed it in his own new tomb that he had cut out of the rock. He rolled a big stone in front of the entrance to the tomb and went away. ⁶² The next day, the chief priests and the Pharisees went to Pilate (*went into a conversation*). ⁶³ "Sir," they said, "we remember that while he was still alive that deceiver said, 'After three days I will rise again.' ⁶⁴ So give the order for the tomb to be made secure until



the third day. Otherwise, his disciples may come and steal the body and tell the people that he has been raised from the dead. This last deception will be worse than the first." ⁶⁵ "Take a guard," Pilate answered. "Go, make the tomb as secure as you know how." ⁶⁶ So they went and made the tomb secure by putting a seal on the stone and posting the guard.

What they did not realize was that God listened to the conversation. God shows Himself strong on behalf of those whose hearts are fully devoted to Him.

Matthew 28

"¹After the Sabbath, at dawn on the first day of the week, ² there was a violent earthquake, for an angel of the Lord came down from heaven and, going to the tomb, rolled back the stone and sat on it. ³ His appearance was like lightning, and his clothes were white as snow. ⁴ The guards were so afraid of him that they shook and became like dead men."

Brethren, do not be anxious about anything. The Lord will fight your battles.



In Genesis 19,

¹⁵ ...the angels urged Lot, saying, "Hurry! Take your wife and your two daughters who are here, or you will be swept away when the city is punished." ... ¹⁷ As soon as they had brought them out, one of them said, "Flee for your lives! Don't look back, and don't stop anywhere in the plain!

²⁶ But Lot's wife looked back, and she became a pillar of salt.

In Luke 5

¹⁸ Some men came carrying a paralyzed man on a mat and tried to take him into the house to lay him before Jesus. ¹⁹ When they could not find a way to do this because of the crowd, they went up on the roof and lowered him on his mat through the tiles into the middle of the crowd, right in front of Jesus.

²⁰ When Jesus saw their faith, he said, "Friend, your sins are forgiven."

²¹ The Pharisees and the teachers of the law <u>began thinking to themselves</u>, "Who is this fellow who speaks blasphemy? Who can forgive sins but God alone?"

Brethren, they were only thinking. Yet Jesus listened and heard them.

²² Jesus knew what they were thinking and asked, "Why are you thinking these



things in your hearts?

²³ Which is easier: to say, 'Your sins are forgiven,' or to say, 'Get up and walk'? ²⁴ But I want you to know that the Son of Man has authority on earth to forgive sins." So he said to the paralyzed man, "I tell you, get up, take your mat and go home." ²⁵ Immediately he stood up in front of them, took what he had been lying on and went home praising God. ²⁶ Everyone was amazed and gave praise to God. They were filled with awe and said, "We have seen remarkable things today."

Brethren,

The Lord wants us to enjoy the fullness of JOY. And not to be anxious about any situation that inflicts pains on you or anybody that talks evil about you or undermines you. In all, God is listening and fights the battle for the righteous.

If we focus on strengthening our relationship with God; He will handle the rest.
