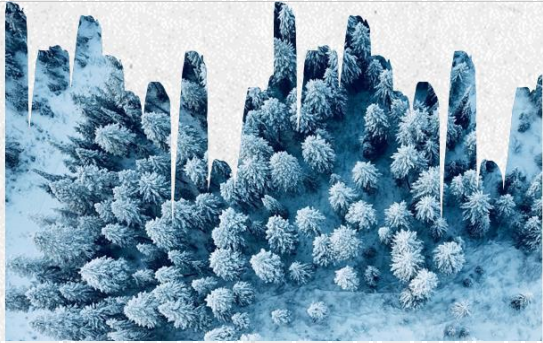


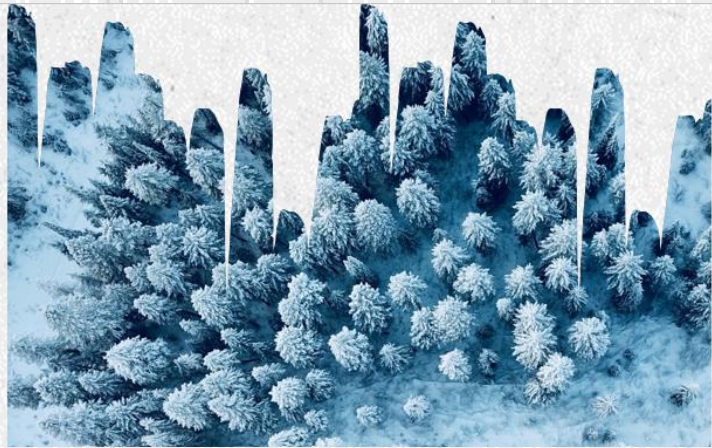

2 CORINTHIANS 3:18

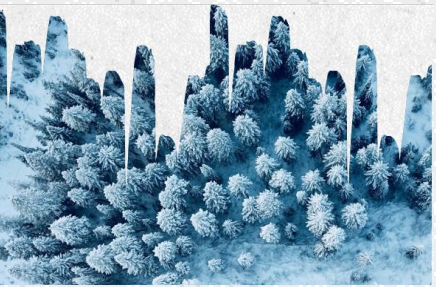

“Now to Him who is able to do immeasurably more than all we ask or imagine, according to His power that is at work within us, be the glory throughout all generations, forever and ever. Amen”

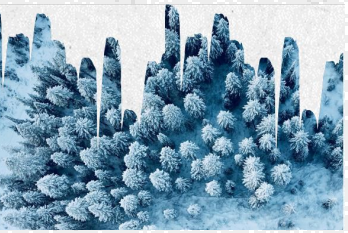
THE FULLNESS OF JOY

This mean we not need to fight again the battles He has already forth for us.

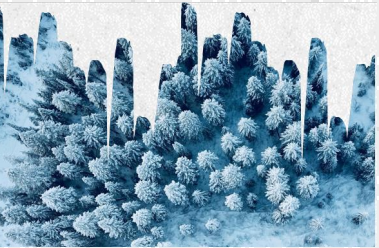
In **John 16:33** Jesus said

Philippians 2:8-10

Our greatness is His greatness.

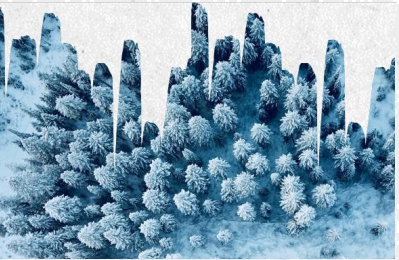
Daniel 7:14

Brethren, the roadmap is clear...

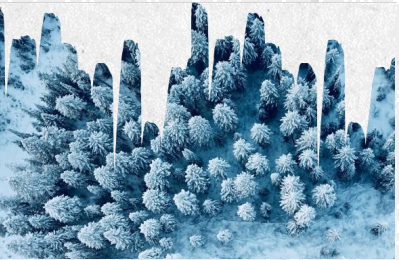
i. Holy Spirit is key

ii. Connect and Be Active as the Spirit leads You


Acts 2:42-47

Acts 13:8-12
