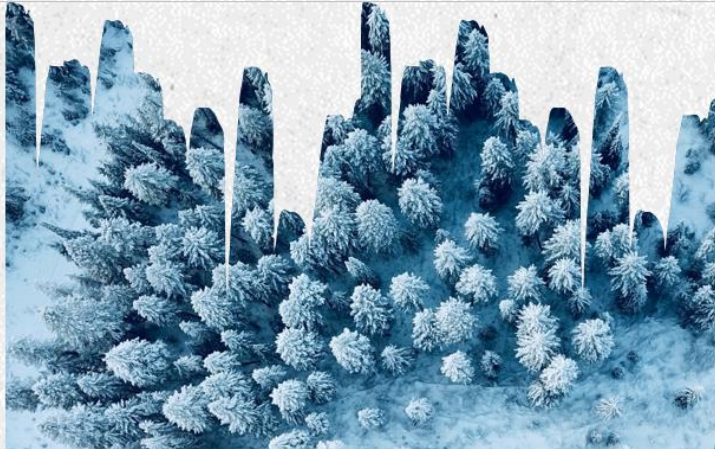

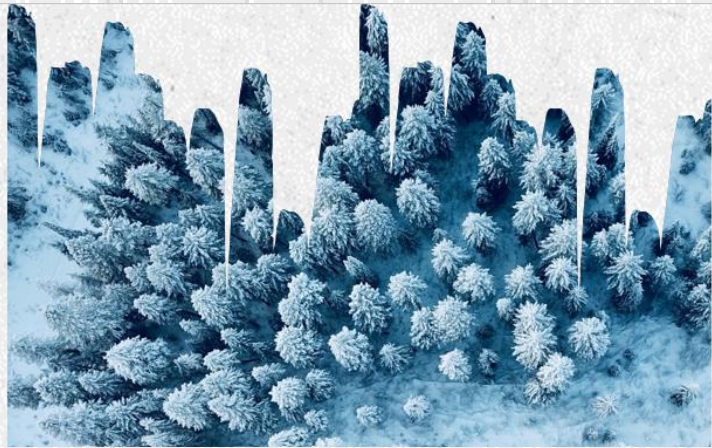

Psalms 110:1

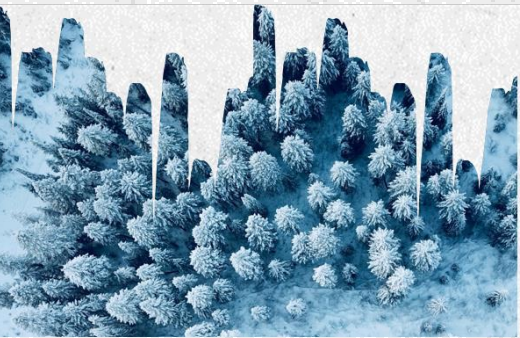
The LORD says to my lord: “Sit at my right hand until I make your **enemies a footstool for your feet.**”

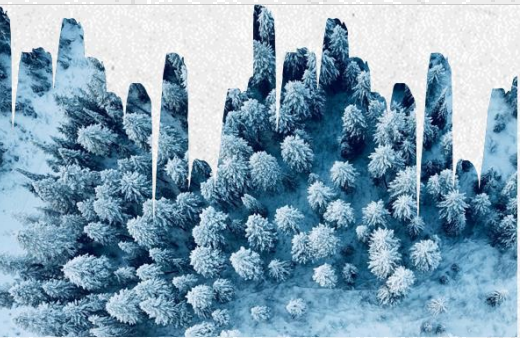
But Jesus sat down because His work is finished:

John 19:30 “Jesus said, “It is finished.” With that, he bowed his head and gave up His spirit.”

Hebrews 10:12-13 “¹² But when this priest had offered for all time one sacrifice for sins, He sat down at the right hand of God, ¹³ and since that time He waits for his enemies to be made his footstool.”

But we are still on earth, we have not finished the work, what is our footstool?





In Ephesians 1:18-23, Paul said to the Saint:

¹⁸ I pray that the eyes of your heart may be enlightened in order that you may know the hope to which He has called you, the riches of His glorious inheritance in His Saints, ¹⁹ and His incomparably great power for us who believe. That power is the same as the mighty strength ²⁰ He exerted when He raised Christ from the dead **and**

seated Him at His right hand in the heavenly realms,

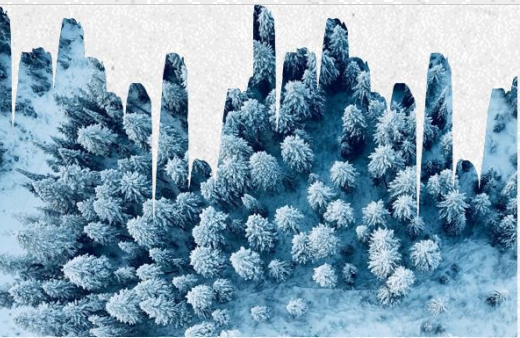
²¹ far above all rule and authority, power and dominion, and every name that is invoked, not only in the present age but also in the one to come.

²² **And God placed all things under His feet** and appointed Him to be head over everything for the church (His Saint), ²³ which is His body, the fullness of Him who fills everything in every way.

Brethren, that same power that raised Jesus from death and seated Him at the right hand of God is the power God has released to us on earth.

Ephesians 2 say we are “Made Alive in Christ.”

1 As for you, you were dead in your transgressions and sins, **2** in which you used to live when you followed the ways of this world, **4** But because of



His great love for us, God, who is rich in mercy, ⁵ made us alive with Christ even when we were dead in transgressions—it is by grace you have been saved.

⁶ And God raised us up with Christ and seated us with him in the heavenly realms in Christ Jesus.

²² And in Him you too are being built together to become a dwelling in which God lives by his Spirit.

1 Corinthians 6:19

¹⁹ Do you not know that your bodies are temples (a building) of the Holy Spirit, who is in you, whom you have received from God?

In **Isaiah 28:16**, God said:

“Behold, I am laying in Zion a stone, a tested stone, A costly cornerstone for the foundation, firmly placed.”

Matthew 7:24-25 “Therefore everyone who hears these words of Mine and acts on them, may be compared to a wise man who built his house on the rock. ²⁵ The rain came down, the streams rose, and the winds blew and beat against that house; yet it did not fall, because it had its foundation on the rock.”

Brethren, our footstool is **the ROCK**, the **FOUNDATION** that Jesus has laid, **the WORD OF GOD**.

Ephesians 6: 11-

¹¹ Put on the full armor of God, so that you can take your stand against the devil's schemes.

¹² For our struggle is ... is against the rulers, against the authorities, against the powers of this dark world and against the spiritual forces of evil in the heavenly realms.

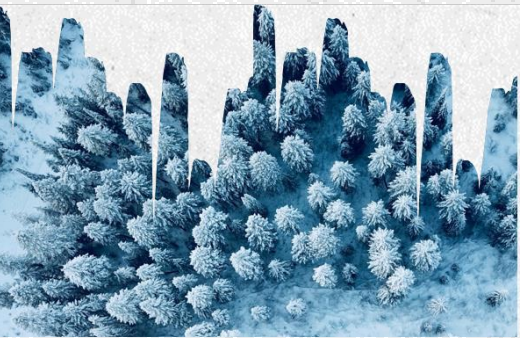
¹⁵ with your feet fitted with the readiness that comes from the gospel of peace.

Matthew 24:35

"Heaven and earth will pass away, but My words will never pass away."

Anywhere you walk/go, you will find **three living things**: the Grass, the flowers/trees and the Word of God.

Hebrews 4:12 "**12** the word of God is living and active."



Isaiah 40:8

“The grass withers and the flowers fall, but the word of our God stands forever.”

Psalm 97:11 “Light (the Word of God) is sown for the righteous” – light is sown in the ground for the righteous.

The Word of God our footstool.

In John 8:12, Jesus said:

“I am the light of the world. Whoever follows Me will never walk in the darkness, but will have the light of life.”

Psalm 119:105, David said “Thy Word Is a Lamp Unto My Feet and Light Unto My Path.”

We are required to use the Word of God as our footstool (**Psalm 119:105**)
