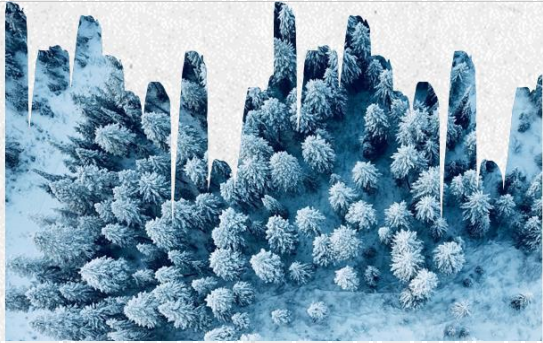

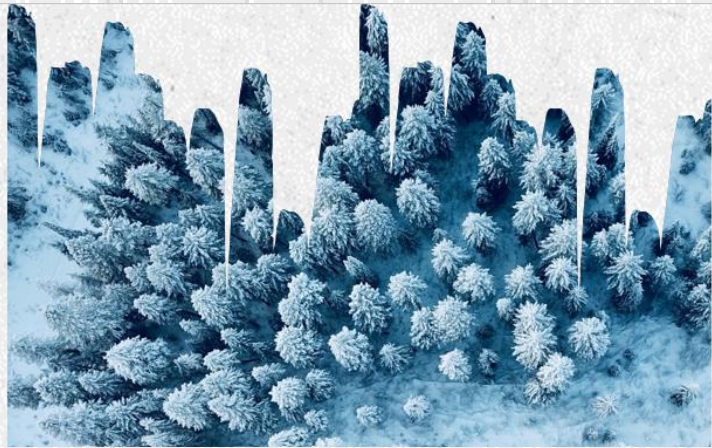

2 CORINTHIANS 3:18

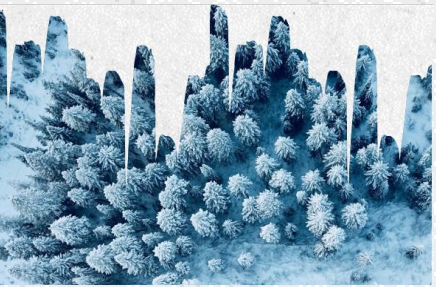

“Now to Him who is able to do immeasurably more than all we ask or imagine, according to His power that is at work within us, be the glory throughout all generations, forever and ever. Amen”

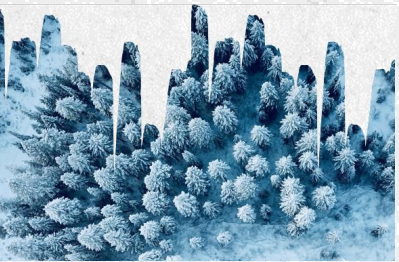
THE FULLNESS OF JOY

Brethren, in 21 episodes, we received responses from God on our singular question: *“what should I do to make God come to me as the Lord Almighty?”*



Armed with the responses, we continued on our journey on Higher Glory.

When we experience ‘Higher Glory’ as a result of God coming to us as ‘the Lord Almighty’, there is **“THE FULLNESS OF JOY” AND WHATEVER YOU ASK IN HIS NAME, HE WILL DO IT”**.



In John 14: 13-14, Jesus said,

¹³I will do whatever you ask in My name, so that the Father may be glorified in the Son.

¹⁴ If you ask Me for anything in My name, I will do it.

Proverbs 18:10 “The name of the LORD is a strong tower; the righteous run to it and are safe”

There has always been POWER in the name of Jesus Christ.

John 1:1 confirms that His Name was “the Word”.

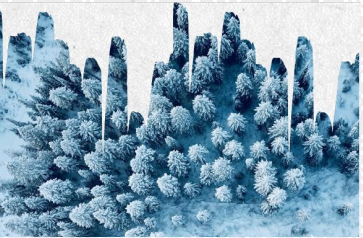
“In the beginning was **the Word**, and **the Word** was with God, and **the Word** was God. ² He was with God in the beginning. ³ Through him all things were made; without him nothing was made that has been made. (John 1:1-3).

Jesus was the Word that God was speaking and things were coming to be.

In Genesis 1:1 God the Father created the Heaven and the Earth

“¹In the beginning God created the heavens and the earth.”

² But the earth was formless and empty, darkness was over the surface of the deep, and the Spirit of God was hovering over the waters.



At this point, we see God the Father, we see the God the Holy Spirit, But where is Jesus? And “darkness was over the surface of the deep.”

Answer, Jesus was **the Word** in the mouth of God the Father (‘the Word was with God’) and when God spoke Him things came to pass.

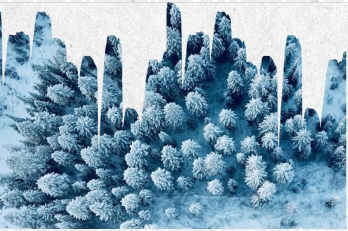
In John 8:12, Jesus said “I am the light of the world. Whoever follows me will never walk in darkness, but will have the light of life.”

Therefore, the first thing God the Father did was to speak the Word in His mouth so that light would shine in the darkness.

Genesis 1: **³ And God said, “Let there be light,” and there was light. ⁴ God saw that the light was good, and He separated the light from the darkness. ⁵ God called the light “day,” and the darkness he called “night.” And there was evening, and there was morning—the first day.**

Brethren, if God the Father knew the POWER of Jesus Chris in His tongue and used it, why can't we know the same POWER in our tongue so we can use it?

Proverbs 18:21 says "21 Death and life are in the power of the tongue, and those who love it will eat its fruits."



God the Father made all things through the Power in His tongue:

Each time God the Father spoke, He was specific on what He wanted.

Genesis 1:

⁶ And God said, "Let there be a vault between the waters to separate water from water." ⁷ And it was so.

⁹ And God said, "Let the water under the sky be gathered to one place, and let dry ground appear." And it was so.

¹¹ Then God said, "Let the land produce vegetation: seed-bearing plants and trees on the land that bear fruit with seed in it, according to their various kinds."

John 1:14 says...

"¹⁴ The Word became flesh and made his dwelling among us. We have seen his glory, the glory of the one and only Son, who came from the Father, full of grace and truth."

No wonder before His arrival, John was told to go and tell the people that the Light of the World is coming.

John 1:

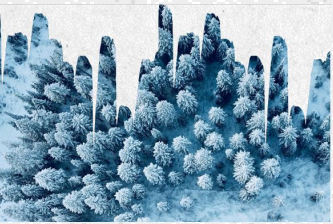
⁶ There was a man sent from God whose name was John. ⁷ He came as a witness to testify concerning that light, so that through him all might believe. ⁸ He himself was not the light; he came only as a witness to the light.

¹⁰ He was in the world, and though the world was made through Him, the world did not recognize Him.

... ¹² **Yet to all** who did receive Him, to those who believed in His name, He gave the right to become children of God— ¹³ children born not of natural descent, nor of human decision or a husband's will, but born of God.

Brethren, because we are now prepared for God to come to us as “the Lord Almighty”, Jesus said , **“WHATEVER YOU ASK IN MY NAME, I WILL DO IT”**.

Let us take a cue from God the Father and ask specific thing with specific words. God did not mumble up all His requests



Examples

In Acts 3, in specific words, ⁶ Peter said, “Silver or gold I do not have, but what I do have I give you. In the name of Jesus Christ of Nazareth, walk.”

⁷ Taking him by the right hand, he helped him up, and instantly the man’s feet and ankles became strong. ⁸ He jumped to his feet and began to walk.

When Peter was questioned, he said:

Acts 4: ¹⁰ know this, you and all the people of Israel: It is by the name of Jesus Christ of Nazareth, whom you crucified but whom God raised from the dead, that this man stands before you healed. ¹¹ Jesus is

“the stone you builders rejected, which has become the cornerstone.”

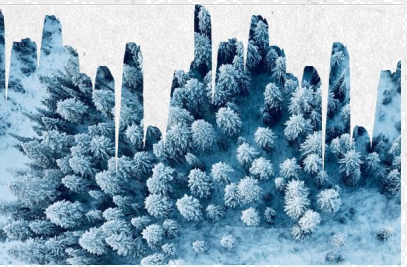
¹² **Salvation is found in no one else, for there is no other name under heaven given to mankind by which we must be saved.”**

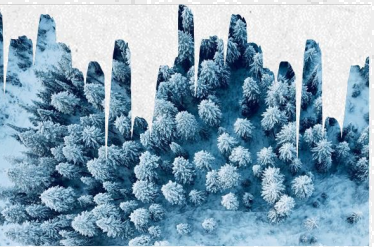
..... Through Jesus, all things are possible

⁹ Therefore God exalted Him to the highest place and gave Him the name that is above every name, ¹⁰ that at the name of Jesus every knee should bow, in heaven and on earth and under the earth, ¹¹ and every tongue acknowledge that Jesus Christ is Lord, to the glory of God the Father.

Mark 10:27 “Jesus looked at them and said, 'With man this is impossible, but not with God; all things are possible with God.’”

Luke 18:27

Jesus replied, “What is impossible with man is possible with God.”
