Feb 11, 2018: At the Mountain Top (Visioning is Key)

Isaiah 2:2-3 (Micah 4:1-2)

In the last days the mountain of the LORD's temple will be established as the highest of the mountains; it will be exalted above the hills, and all nations will stream to it.

3And many peoples will come and say, "Come, let us go up to the mountain of the LORD, To the house of the God of Jacob; That He may <u>teach</u> us concerning His <u>ways</u> And that we may walk in His <u>paths</u>." For the <u>law</u> will go forth from Zion And the word of the LORD from Jerusalem.

Isaiah 25:6

The LORD of hosts will prepare a lavish <u>banquet</u> for all peoples on this mountain; A banquet of aged wine, choice pieces with marrow, And refined, aged wine.

Isaiah 27:13

It will come about also in that day that those who were perishing in the land of Assyria and who were scattered in the land of Egypt will come and worship the LORD in the holy mountain at Jerusalem. Nurturing people will be important.

Isaiah 56:7

Even those I will bring to My holy mountain And make them joyful in My house of prayer. Their <u>burnt offerings and their sacrifices</u> will be acceptable on My altar; For My house will be called a <u>house of prayer</u> for all the peoples."

at the mountain top, Psalm 22:27 say: All the ends of the earth will remember and turn to the LORD, And all the families of the nations will worship before the Lord.

Isaiah 52:7

How beautiful upon the mountains Are the feet of him who brings good news, Who proclaims peace, Who brings glad tidings of good *things*, Who proclaims salvation, Who says to Zion, "Your God reigns!"

Isaiah 65:1-12

I I"But you who forsake the LORD, Who forget My holy mountain, Who set a table for Fortune, And who fill cups with mixed wine for Destiny, I 2I will destine you for the sword, And all of you will bow down to the slaughter.

The Path to the Mountain Starts with His Call

Moses was called.

Jesus was called.

Paul was called.

The disciples were called.

Many are called.

You & I are called.

Moses was called

Exodus 3: ¹⁻² Moses was shepherding the flock of Jethro, his father-in-law, the priest of Midian. He led the flock to the west end of the wilderness and came to the mountain of God, Horeb. The angel of GOD appeared to him in flames of fire blazing out of the middle of a bush. He looked. The bush was blazing away but it didn't burn up.

³ Moses said, "What's going on here? I can't believe this! Amazing! Why doesn't the bush burn up?"

⁴ GOD saw that he had stopped to look. God called to him from out of the bush, "Moses! Moses!"

He said, "Yes? I'm right here!"

Mount Horeb depicts the mountain we are talking about --- where God's power comes forth. Moses was called to an assignment he had demonstrated passion in before. . free Israelites.

God said:

⁹⁻¹⁰ "The Israelite cry for help has come to me, and I've seen for myself how cruelly they're being treated by the Egyptians. It's time for you to go back: I'm sending you to Pharaoh to bring my people, the People of Israel, out of Egypt."

Brethren, at our maintain top, the power of God must come out, people will be delivered, & nations will be set free.

II Moses answered God, "But why me? What makes you think that I could ever go to Pharaoh and lead the children of Israel out of Egypt?"

12"I'll be with you," God said. "And this will be the proof that I am the one who sent you: When you have brought my people out of Egypt, you will worship God right here at this very mountain."

According to the book of Deuteronomy 5, went back to mount Horeb to worship God.

Moses said to the Israelites:

²⁻⁵ GOD, our God, made a covenant with us at Horeb. GOD didn't just make this covenant with our parents; he made it also with us, with all of us who are alive right now. GOD spoke to you personally out of the fire on the mountain. At the time I stood between GOD and you, to tell you what GOD said. You were afraid, remember, of the fire and wouldn't climb the mountain. He said:

⁶I am GOD, your God, who brought you out of the land of Egypt, out of a house of slaves. ⁷ No other gods, only me.

Exodus 24:17 calls Hebron experience mount Sinai.

16The glory of the LORD rested on Mount Sinai, and the cloud covered it for six days; and on the seventh day He called to Moses from the midst of the cloud. I7And to the eyes of the sons of Israel the appearance of the glory of the LORD was like a consuming fire on the mountain top. 18Moses entered the midst of the cloud as he went up to the mountain; and Moses was on the mountain forty days and forty nights
