Part 8: Strive for the Top: Milk to Meat to Bone (2 Timothy 2:15)

“Work hard so you can present yourself to God and receive His approval. Be a good worker, one who does not need to be ashamed and who correctly explains the word of truth.”

Part 9: Defend the Course

Protect, justify, and maintain the specific intended direction despite facing criticism, opposition or setbacks.

This requires Strategic Action: maintaining a previously decided position even in the face of pressure to change it.

Part 10: Embrace “Let Your Will Be Done”

Letting go of control and trusting a higher purpose.

Not just passive acceptance—it’s actively striving to live in a way that reflects God’s plan “on earth.”. Involves **Knowledge** of God’s plan, **Obedience**, **Trust and Humility** towards higher purpose.

Text **Matthew 6:6-10**

Part 10: Embrace “Let Your Will Be Done”

Matthew 6:6-10

“⁶ But when you pray, go into your room, close the door and pray to your Father, who is unseen. Then your Father, who sees what is done in secret, will reward you.”

“⁷ And when you pray, do not keep on babbling like pagans, for they think they will be heard because of their many words. ⁸ Do not be like them, for your Father knows what you need before you ask him.”

⁹ “This, then, is how you should pray:

““Our Father in heaven, hallowed be your name, ¹⁰ your kingdom come, **“your will be done”**, “on earth as it is in heaven.”

Be done on earth as it is in heaven?

The Bible describes heaven as a magnificent, holy city called the New Jerusalem (Revelation 21:2), designed for God’s presence (Revelation 21:3). It features foundations of precious stones (Revelation 21:19-20), walls of jasper (Revelation 21:18), and twelve gates of pearl (Revelation 21:21). It is depicted as a place of absolute glory, joy, and peace, free from pain, death, and tears (Rev. 21:4), illuminated by God rather than the sun (Rev. 22:5).



Part 10: Embrace “Let Your Will Be Done”

What is God’s plan for us on earth?

Ephesians 1:10: ¹⁰ (God plans)—to bring unity to all things in heaven and on earth under Christ.
¹¹ He works out everything in conformity with the purpose of His will.

Isaiah 45:18 says: “God created the earth to be inhabited; He did not create it to be empty “

Jeremiah 29:11 (NIV): “¹¹ For I know the plans I have for you,” declares the LORD, “plans to prosper you and not to harm you, plans to give you hope and a future. ”.

Isaiah 14:24: “Surely, as I have planned, so it will be, and as I have purposed, so it will happen.”

Isaiah 46:10: “My purpose will stand, and I will do all that I please.” ... plans are firm and ultimately fulfilled.

Prov. 19:21: “Many plans are in a man’s heart, but it is the Lord’s purpose that prevails.”

..... *why don’t we start early to align with His purpose?*



Jeremiah 10:23: “I know that people’s lives are not their own; it is not for them to direct their steps.”

Psalms 37:23: “The LORD directs the steps of the godly. He delights in every detail of their lives.”

Jeremiah 23:20: “...the Lord will not turn back until he fully accomplishes the purposes of his heart.”
