# LIFT UP THE NAME, JESUS CHRIST.

**John 14:6**, Jesus said, "I am the way, and the truth, and the life. No one comes to the Father except through me.

**John 12: 32** And I, when I am lifted up from the earth, will draw everyone to Myself"

**John 3:14-15**

**14**Just as Moses lifted up the snake in the wilderness, so the Son of Man must be lifted up. **15** that everyone who believes in Him may have eternal life.

**Numbers 21:8** "Then the LORD said to Moses, "Make a fiery serpent and mount it on a pole. When anyone who is bitten looks at it, he will live."

**John 8:28** "So Jesus said, "When you have lifted up the Son of Man, then you will know that I am He."

**John 14:13** "Whatever you ask in my name, this I will do."

**Provs 18:10** "The name of the LORD is a strong tower; the righteous runs into it & is safe."

**Brethren, God says if we want testimony, then lift up the name, Jesus Christ.**

**In Philippians 4:13**, Paul said “<sup>13</sup> I can do all things through Christ who strengthens me.”

### **Philippians 2:9-11**

God has highly exalted Jesus Christ and bestowed on Him the name that is above every name, **so that at the name of Jesus every knee should bow, in heaven and on earth and under the earth**, and every tongue confess that Jesus Christ is Lord, to the glory of God the Father.

### **Philippians 2, Paul said:**

<sup>1</sup> Is there any encouragement from belonging to Christ? Any comfort from His love? Any fellowship together in the Spirit? Are your hearts tender and compassionate? <sup>2</sup> Then make me truly happy by agreeing wholeheartedly with each other, loving one another, and working together with one mind and purpose.

- <sup>3</sup> Don't be selfish; don't try to impress others. Be humble, thinking of others as better than yourselves.
- <sup>4</sup> Don't look out only for your own interests, but take an interest in others, too.
- <sup>5</sup> You must have the same attitude that Christ Jesus had.
  - He gave up his divine privileges; he took the humble position of a slave
  - He humbled himself in obedience to God

### **1. In our Words and Defense of Faith**

**Colossians 4:6** "Let your speech always be gracious, seasoned with salt, so that you may know how you ought to answer each person."

**1 Peter 3:15** "In your hearts revere Christ as Lord. Always be prepared to give an answer to everyone who asks you to give the reason for the hope that you have. But do this with gentleness and respect,"

## **2 Timothy 2:25**

He must gently reprove those who oppose him, in the hope that God may grant them repentance leading to a knowledge of the truth.

**In Psalm 150:1-6, David said:**

“Praise the LORD! Praise God in His sanctuary; praise Him in His mighty heavens! Praise Him for his mighty deeds; praise Him according to his excellent greatness! Praise Him with trumpet sound; praise Him with lute and harp! Praise Him with tambourine and dance; praise Him with strings and pipe! “Do nothing from rivalry or conceit, but in humility count others more significant than yourselves. Let each of you look not only to his own interests, but also to the interests of others.”

**Colossians 3:17** “And whatever you do, in word or deed, do everything in the name of the Lord Jesus, giving thanks to God the Father through him.”
