TEXTS:

Isaiah 66:1

“This is what the LORD says: “Heaven is my throne, and the earth is my footstool. Where is the house you will build for me? Where will my resting place be?”

Brethren, this is an important question: “Do you have a place for God to rest in”?

Isaiah 40:22 says “God sits enthroned above the circle of the earth, He stretches out the heavens like a canopy, and spreads them out like a tent to live in.

When God stretches out the heaven, He actually uses it to cover any tent (house) He finds worthy.

2 Corinthians 5:1-5 says “¹We know that if the earthly tent we live in is destroyed,

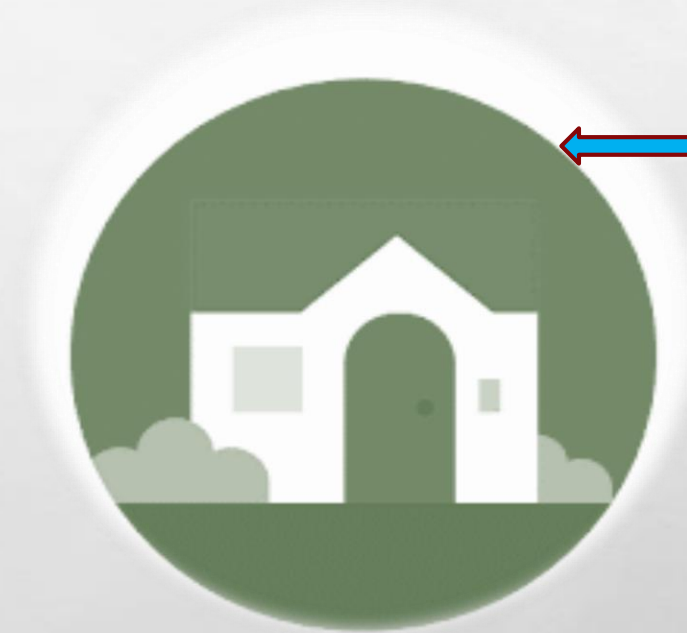
we have a building from God, an eternal house in heaven, not built by human hands....

4 For while we are in this tent, we groan ..., because we do not wish to be unclothed but to be clothed instead with our heavenly dwelling.

It means that while we are here on earth, our focus and goal should be to live righteous enough to get God to cloth our home with a copy of heaven.

Psalm 91:1 says “He who dwells in the secret place of the Most High Shall abide under the shadow of the Almighty.

Beyond making heaven, there is a huge benefit on earth when we “Make Our Home God’s Dwelling Place.”

For instance,

Hebrews 12 says ¹⁸ You have not come to a physical mountain, to a place of flaming fire, darkness, gloom, and whirlwind...²² No, you have come to Mount Zion,

- to the city of the living God, the heavenly Jerusalem, and
- to countless thousands of angels in a joyful gathering.
- ²³ You have come to the assembly of God’s firstborn children, whose names are written in heaven.
- You have come to God Himself, who is the judge over all things.
- You have come to the spirits of the righteous ones in heaven who have now been made perfect.
- ²⁴ You have come to Jesus, the one who mediates the new covenant between God and people, and to the sprinkled blood, which speaks of forgiveness instead of crying out for vengeance like the blood of Abel.

Hebrews 12 warns us to: ²⁵ Be careful that you do not refuse to listen to the One who is speaking.

Brethren, God uses the earth as His footstool.

Isaiah 40:22 talks about the **circle of the earth.**

Science tells us that the earth **spins around its axis**. This spinning movement is called Earth's rotation.

So if the earth rotates and God uses it as its footstool, it means there is no part of the earth that does not go under the foot of God. It further means that there is nothing on earth that is not under the control of God.

Brethren, as the earth passes under His feet, many things happen:

- Everything on earth passes under His feet
- Light from heaven beams through the earth

- mercy of God rains on earth
- Grace of God abounds on earth
- Power of God rules over the earth
- Anointing of God fires into earth; if it finds good, it blesses, if it finds bad, it consumes
- Glory of God covers the earth and man can behold it unless the man sins
- Rhema word of God comes down to the earth, we can hear Him and He can hear us
- Commands of God come down to earth, and God sets His rules on how the earth should be governed
- Replicates of heaven are created and they come down like canopy to cover homes that have been prepared for God
- Connection flows between heaven and earth, reason they can instantly see and start rejoicing in heaven when a soul is won.

Hebrews 12: ²⁵ Be careful that you do not refuse to listen to the One who is speaking.

David is an example of someone who understood the principle

1 Chronicles 28

² King David rose to his feet and said: “Listen to me, my fellow Israelites, my people. I had it in my heart to build a house as a place of rest for the ark of the covenant of the LORD, for the footstool of our God, and I made plans to build it. ³ But God said to me, ‘You are not to build a house for my Name, because you are a warrior and have shed blood.’

⁴ “Yet the LORD, the God of Israel, chose me from my whole family to be king over Israel forever.

Psalms 91:9-10 “Because you have made the LORD, your dwelling place, No evil shall befall you.
