FIND THE RISING SUN

Malachi 4:2

“For you who fear My name, the sun of righteousness will rise with healing in its wings, and you will go out and leap like calves from the stall.”

What this means is that there is no pain/call/hope/expectation of the righteous that the Lord will not respond to. He is interested in giving us testimonies. testimonies.

Proverbs 23:18-19 says “For surely there is a future, and your hope will not be cut off. **19** Listen, my son, and be wise, and guide your heart on the right course.”

Hebrews 10:35 “So do not throw away your confidence; it will be richly rewarded.”

Brethren, we must hold-on to our confidence and find the rising sun.

- **God said the sun will rise to bring His response in the area you need help.**

We do not need to beat about the bush. Stand firm on what you need from Him and He will do it.

- Being assured of the rising sun and keenly looking out for it, keeps us firmly in the presence of God.

Ephesians 3:12

In Him and through faith in Him we may enter God's presence with boldness and confidence.

- **The rising of the sun happens in the presence of God**

If we need testimony, we cannot afford to leave the presence of God

The case of Elijah, presents a lot of lessons for us:

1 Kings 18:41-46

⁴¹ And Elijah said to Ahab, “Go, eat and drink, for there is the sound of a heavy rain.” ⁴² So Ahab went off to eat and drink, but Elijah climbed to the top of Carmel, bent down to the ground and put his face between his knees. ⁴³ “Go and look toward the sea,” he told his servant. And he went up and looked.

“There is nothing there,” he said.

Seven times Elijah said, “Go back.” ⁴⁴ The seventh time the servant reported, “A cloud as small as a man’s hand is rising from the sea.”

So Elijah said, “Go and tell Ahab, ‘Prepare your chariot, and go down before the rain stops you.’” ⁴⁵ Meanwhile, the sky grew black with clouds, the wind rose, a heavy rain started falling and Ahab rode off to Jezreel. ⁴⁶ The power of the LORD came on Elijah and, tucking his cloak into his belt, **he ran ahead of Ahab** all the way to Jezreel – He out-ran Ahab.

Lesson #1: Understand your role: eater or sower? Children of God are sowers.

2 Corinthians 9:10 “God who supplies seed to the sower and bread for food will supply and multiply your seed (your resources) for sowing and then produce a great harvest of generosity (food) in you (for others to eat - **2 Corinthians 9:12**).

Lesson #2: If you need anything from God, don't hands-off until you have received it – find that rising sun.

2 Corinthians 9:8 “And God is able to bless you abundantly, so that in all things at all times, having all that you need, you will abound in every good work.”

Corinthians 1:4 “He comforts us in all our troubles so that we can comfort others.”

Isaiah 54:4 “Do not be afraid; you will not be put to shame. Do not fear disgrace; you will not be humiliated.”

Lesson #3 Even if it delays in coming, keep seeking, it will come – Elijah checked 7-times before he found it. Even when he saw it, it looked so small but he was not discouraged.

Ephesians 3:20 “Now to Him who is able to do far more abundantly beyond all that we ask or think, according to the power that works within us.” – **this is where our faith is key.**

Lesson #4: When you have found it, don't leave in a hurry, ask God for power for speed to out-run.

Joes 2: 25, God said: "I will restore to you what you lost to the swarming locusts, the hopping locusts, the stripping locusts, and the cutting locusts"

Lesson #5: Stay on your lane:

Ensure that what you are asking for is along the path/lot that God has apportioned to you – (if you are praying on behalf of someone else ensure that the person should rightfully be asking for what you are praying for.)

1 Kings 18:1-2 "1....in the third year of the drought, the word of the LORD came to Elijah: "Go and present yourself to Ahab, and I will send rain upon the face of the earth."

It is important to stay in communication with the Holy Spirit to understand your path.

Romans 8:28 "And we know that all things work together for good to them that love God (righteousness), to them who are the called according to his purpose (on your lane).

Brethren, to get our testimony on the glory list of 2021, let us persiste until we find the rising sun along the path apporioned to us.
