FOLLOW THE PATHWAY TO GREATNESS.

- **BUSINESS WORLD CALLS THIS PATHWAY A “NICHE” ...**

.... *“to find one's niche in the business world - a small, specialized market for a particular product or service.”*

Once you find this, you will be great in that business.

- **SCRIPTURE CALLS THIS PATHWAY A NARROW ROAD (Matthew 7:13-14)**

... “Small is the gate and narrow the road that leads to life, and only a few find it.”

How Do We Find It?

Jesus said: “I am the light of the world. Whoever follows Me will never walk in the darkness, but will have the light of life.” **(John 8:12)**

The PROMISE

Deuteronomy 28:

“**1**If you fully obey the LORD your God and carefully **follow** all His commands (you receive), the LORD your God will set you high above all the nations on earth.”

- **3** You will be blessed in the city and blessed in the country.
- **7** The LORD will grant that the enemies who rise up against you will be defeated before you.
- **8** The LORD will send a blessing on everything you put your hand to.
- **10** All the peoples on earth will see that you are called by the name of the LORD, and they will fear you.
- **11** The LORD will grant you abundant prosperity.
- **12** You will lend to many nations but will borrow from none.
- **13** The LORD will make you the head, not the tail.

So, God is delighted to see us become great, are we prepared to follow His pathway?

“You are the light of the world. A city on a hill cannot be hidden.” (Matthew 5:14).

Jesus said, “While I am in the world, I am the light of the world.” (John 9:5)

Brethren, we are witnesses to the legacy Jesus left as the light of the world.

God will enable us to leave our own legacy, if we are ready to follow the pathway.

“While you have the Light, believe in the Light, so that you may become sons of light.” (John 12:36)

“I have come into the world as a light, so that no one who believes in Me should remain in darkness.” (John 12:46).

What makes the difference is our ability to find and follow our pathway to greatness.

“If we say we have fellowship with Him yet walk in the darkness, we lie and do not practice the truth.” **(1John 1:6)**

The likes of David found this pathway to greatness and became great.

David said: “You light a lamp for me. The LORD, my God, lights up my darkness.”
(Psalm 18:28)

Finding this light and pathway gave David confidence:

“The LORD is my light and my salvation--whom shall I fear? The LORD is the stronghold of my life--whom shall I dread? (Psalm 27:1).

“**29**O LORD, you are my lamp. The LORD lights up my darkness. **30**In your strength I can crush an army; with my God I can scale any wall. **31**“God’s way is perfect. All the LORD’s promises prove true. He is a shield for all who look to him for protection - who take refuge in Him”. **(2 Samuel 22:29-31).**

David continued on this pathway and God continued to bless him.

In 2 Samuel 7,

“1After King David had settled into his palace and the LORD had given him rest from all his enemies around him, **2**he said to Nathan the prophet, “Here I am, living in a house of cedar, while the ark of God remains in a tent.” **3**And Nathan replied to the king, “Go and do all that is in your heart, for the LORD is with you.”

4But that night the word of the LORD came to Nathan, saying, ... **8**..Go and tell My servant David that this is what the LORD of Hosts says: I took you from the pasture, from following the flock, to be the ruler over My people Israel. **9**I have been with you wherever you have gone, and I have cut off all your enemies from before you. **Now I will make for you a name like the greatest in the land.**

Jeremiah 33:17 “this is what the LORD says: 'David will never fail to have a man to sit on the throne of Israel,’”

Brethren, the Lord tells us to “Follow the Pathway to greatness”

His word is the lamp that shines light into our darkness.

- God gives direction.

Jeremiah 33:3 “Call to me and I will answer you and tell you great and unsearchable things you do not know.”

A prayer as simple as **“God please show me the way to follow”** once it is said with sincerity of heart, God answers.

- He rebukes and scares away devourers on our way

David said: Psalm 125:3 “The scepter of the wicked (rod of the wicked) will not remain over the land allotted to the righteous.”

- He leads us to hidden treasures and releases secrets to us

Isaiah 45: “¹This is what the LORD says to his anointed, whose right hand He takes hold of to subdue nations before him and to strip kings of their armor, to open doors before him so that gates will not be shut:

² I will go before you and will level the mountains;

I will break down gates of bronze and cut through bars of iron.

³ I will give you hidden treasures, riches stored in secret places, so that you may know that I am the LORD, who summons you by name.

Brethren as Spirit filled Christians, all we need to do to get this honour is to:

(1.) Earnestly ask: “**God please show me the way to follow**”

(2.) Listen to your Spirit; whatever the Spirit tells you, write them down and follow through. (“**Any right thing done in faith is not a sin** (Romans 14:23 NLT)

(2.) Then study characters, heroes, in the bible and emulate their good steps on how they worked with God and succeeded. (E.g. Elijah, Elisha, David, Moses, Joshua, Joseph, Deborah, Esther, Peter, Paul, etc.)
