GOD WILL PERFECT THAT WHICH CONCERNS YOU

Text:

Psalm 138:8 David said:

"The LORD will perfect that which concerns me"

Proverbs 10:24

"The desire of the righteous will be granted."

1 Peter 3:12

"The eyes of the Lord are on the righteous, and His ears are open to their prayer"

Psalm 34:15

"The eyes of the LORD are on the righteous, and His ears are inclined to their cry."

Deuteronomy 11:23

"The LORD will drive out all these nations before you, and you will dispossess nations greater and stronger than you."

1. Obedience is KEY to this level of success

Deuteronomy 11:8-12

- ⁸ Observe therefore all the commands I am giving you:
- so that you may have the strength to go in and take over the land that you are crossing the Jordan to possess. (Also see Psalm 24:1-5).
- ⁹ and so that you may live long in the land .., a land flowing with milk and honey.
- ¹⁰ The land you are entering to take over is not like the land of Egypt, from which you have come, where you planted your seed and irrigated it by foot as in a vegetable garden.
- ¹¹ But the land you are crossing the Jordan to take possession of is a land of mountains and valleys that drinks rain from heaven. ¹² It is a land the LORD your God cares for; the eyes of the LORD your God are continually on it from the beginning of the year to its end.

2. Parents, Teach Your Children the Ways of God There are many experiences/stories parents have that the children were not privy to: Deuteronomy 11:2-7

- ² Remember today that your children were not the ones who saw and experienced the discipline of the LORD your God: His majesty, His mighty hand, his outstretched arm; ³ the signs he performed and the things he did in the heart of Egypt, both to Pharaoh king of Egypt and to his whole country; ⁴ what he did to the Egyptian army, to its horses and chariots, how he overwhelmed them with the waters of the Red Sea as they were pursuing you, and how the LORD brought lasting ruin on them.
- ⁵ It was not your children who saw what He did for you in the wilderness until you arrived at this place, ⁶ and what He did to Dathan and Abiram, who rose up against Moses and the earth opened its mouth right in the middle of all Israel and swallowed them up with their households (Numbers 16:1-17). ⁷ But it was your own eyes that saw all these great things the LORD has done.

Deuteronomy 11:18-19 "18 Fix these words of mine in your hearts and minds; tie them as

symbols on your hands and bind them on your foreheads. ¹⁹ Teach them to your children, talking about them when you sit at home and when you walk along the road, when you lie down and when you get up. ²⁰ Write them on the doorframes of your houses and on your gates, ²¹ so that your days and the days of your children may be many in the land the LORD swore to give your ancestors, as many as the days that the heavens are above the earth.

Proverbs 22:6 (NIV)

"Start children off on the way they should go, and even when they are old they will not turn from it."

Proverbs 22:6 (NLT)

"Direct your children onto the right path, and when they are older, they will not leave it."

Deuteronomy 5:16

Children, honor your father and your mother, as the LORD your God has commanded you, so that your days may be long and that it may go well with you in the land that the LORD your God is giving you.

Brethren, as we meticulously follow through, GOD WILL PERFECT THAT WHICH CONCERNS US.

No wonder God says, "the battle is not yours but mine" (2 Chronicles 20:15).

- He can provide ideas (2 Kings 7:4-6 let's go over to the camp of the Arameans and surrender.
 The the Lord caused the Arameans to hear the sound of chariots and horses and a great army.)
- He can provide strategies (Joshua 6:1-20 match around the wall of Jericho)
- He can fight for you (Psalm 105:15 "Touch not my anointed and do my prophet no harm")
- He can back your speech/word with power. Reason bible says:
- "Death and life are in the power of the tongue." Proverbs 18:21
- He can magnify your little effort

Psalm 18:33 David said:

"He makes my feet like the feet of a deer; He causes me to stand on the heights." With that Mindset, David faced Goliath:

In 1 Samuel 17:45-50, 45 David said to the Philistine, "You come against me with

sword and spear and javelin, but I come against you in the name of the LORD Almighty, 46 This day the LORD will deliver you into my hands, and I'll strike you down and cut off your head. This very day I will give the carcasses of the Philistine army to the birds and the wild animals, and the whole world will know that there is a God in Israel. ⁴⁷ All those gathered here will know that it is not by sword or spear that the LORD saves; for the battle is the LORD's, and he will give all of you into our hands." ⁴⁸ As the Philistine moved closer to attack him, David ran quickly toward the battle line to meet him. 49 Reaching into his bag and taking out a stone, he slung it and struck the Philistine on the forehead. The stone sank into his forehead, and he fell facedown on the ground. ⁵⁰ So David triumphed over the Philistine with a sling and a stone; without a sword in his hand he struck down the Philistine and killed him.

God backed David's words with power, made his feet like the dear and made him ride on heights. Today, we read and talk about David.

Psalm 57:2 "I will cry unto God most high; unto God that performs all things for me."

Brethren, if you are a king, you need to live as one. If God will perfect that which concern you, then DO NOT fight the battle. Do not be afraid, rather, the bible says, 'stay positive':

"Whatever things are true, whatever things are noble, whatever things are just, whatever things are pure, whatever things are lovely, whatever things are of good report, if there is any virtue and if there is anything praiseworthy—meditate on these things.". Phil 4:8
