Texts:

Joshua 10:12-14 - God made the sun to stand still for Joshua.

Daniel 6: 22 - God shut the mouth of the lion for Daniel

Joshua 10: 1-14

¹² On the day the LORD gave the Amorites over to Israel, Joshua said to the LORD in the presence of Israel:

“Sun, stand still over Gibeon, and you, moon, over the Valley of Aijalon.”

¹³ So the sun stood still, and the moon stopped, till the nation avenged itself on its enemies.

The sun stopped in the middle of the sky and delayed going down about a full day.

¹⁴ **There has never been a day like it before or since, a day when the LORD listened to a human being.** Surely the LORD was fighting for Israel!

Daniel 6: 16-22

¹⁶ the king gave the order, and they brought Daniel and threw him into the lions' den. The king said to Daniel, "May your God, whom you serve continually, rescue you!"

¹⁷ A stone was brought and placed over the mouth of the den, and the king sealed it with his own signet ring and with the rings of his nobles, so that Daniel's situation might not be changed.¹⁹ At the first light of dawn, the king got up and hurried to the lions'

den. ²⁰ When he came near the den, he called to Daniel in an anguished voice, "**Daniel, servant of the living God, has your God, whom you serve continually, been able to**

rescue you from the lions?"

²¹ Daniel answered, "May the king live forever! ²² **My God sent his angel, and he shut the mouths of the lions.** They have not hurt me, because I was found innocent in his sight. Nor have I ever done any wrong before you, Your Majesty."



Part 11: God makes all things Possible for You

Brethren, God makes all things possible for you.

The bible says, “But seek first the kingdom of God and his righteousness, and all these things will be added to you.” (Matthew 6:33).

Brethren, we need to proactively seek God.

"Be ready in season and out of season" (2 Timothy 4:2)

How did Daniel Proactively seek God?

A. ³ king Nebuchadnezzar ordered ... to bring into the king's service some of the Israelites from the royal family and the nobility

— ⁴ young men without any physical defect, handsome, showing aptitude for every kind of learning, well informed, quick to understand, and qualified to serve in the king's palace. He was to teach them the language and literature of the Babylonians. ⁵ The king assigned them a daily amount of food and wine from the king's table. They were to be trained for three years, and after that they were to enter the king's service.



⁶ Among those who were chosen were some from Judah: Daniel, etc.

So, right from beginning, Daniel had important distinctive character!

.... showed aptitude for every kind of learning, well informed, quick to understand, and qualified to serve.

"The one who is unwilling to work shall not eat" (Thessalonians 3:10)

How did Daniel Proactively seek God?

B. Daniel 6: ⁵ The king assigned them a daily amount of food and wine from the king's table..... ⁸ But Daniel resolved not to defile himself with the royal food and wine, and he asked the chief official for permission not to defile himself this way.

.... **DON'T defile yourself.** ___ seek the kingdom of God and the righteousness of God

C. ⁹ Now God had caused the official to show favor and compassion to Daniel, ¹⁰ but the official told Daniel, "I am afraid of my lord the king, who has assigned your^[c] food and drink. Why should he see you looking worse than the other young men your age? The king would then have my head because of you."

... although the prince of Persia attempts to hold God's purposes back (Daniel 10:13), it is for a short while because when God is for you, no one can be against you (Romans 8:31).

D. Trust in the Lord and in the power of His might (Ephesians 6:10)

¹¹ Daniel then said to the guard whom the chief official had appointed over Daniel, Hananiah, Mishael and Azariah, ¹² "Please test your servants for ten days: Give us nothing but vegetables to eat and water to drink. ¹³ Then compare our appearance with that of the young men who eat the royal food, and treat your servants in accordance with what you see."

¹⁴ So he agreed to this and tested them for ten days.

E. ¹⁵ At the end of the ten days they looked healthier and better nourished than any of the young men who ate the royal food. ¹⁶ So the guard took away their choice food and the wine they were to drink and gave them vegetables instead.

.... **“Do not be afraid. Stand firm and you will see the deliverance the LORD will bring you.” (Exodus 14:13; 2 Chronicles 20:17)**

Conclusion

¹⁷ To these four young men (Daniel and the 3 Hebrew boys) God gave knowledge and understanding of all kinds of literature and learning. And Daniel could understand visions and dreams of all kinds. ¹⁸ At the end of the time set by the king to bring them into his service, the chief official presented them to Nebuchadnezzar. ¹⁹ The king talked with them, and he found none equal to Daniel, (and the 3 Hebrew boys); so, they entered the king's service. ²⁰ **In every matter of wisdom and understanding about which the king questioned them, he found them ten times better than all the magicians and enchanters in his whole kingdom.**

All we need is being PROACTIVE in seeking God. Daniel gave us a good example. Let's go and live it.
