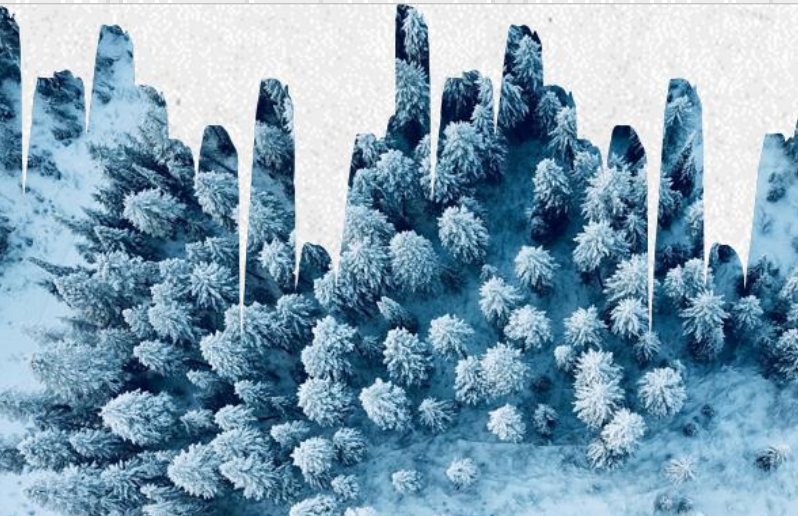

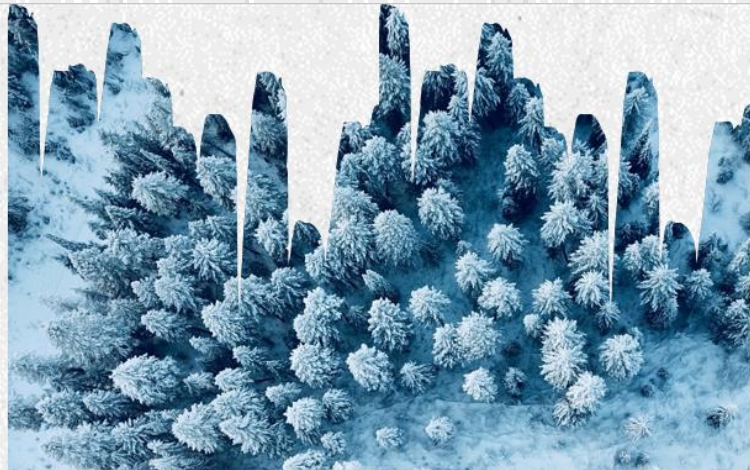

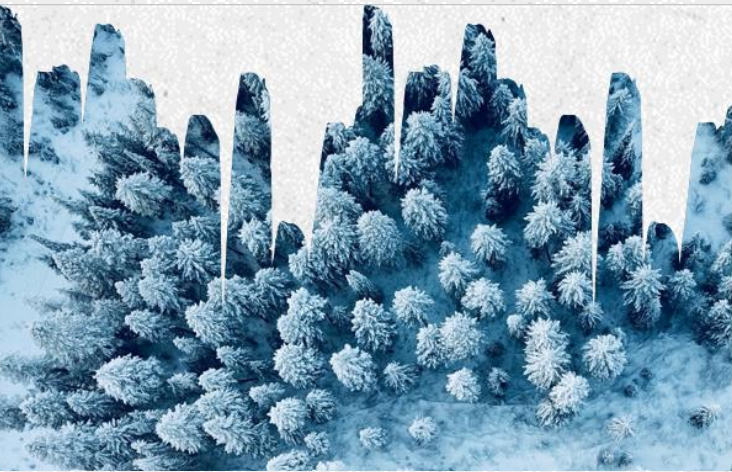
2 CORINTHIANS 3:18

“Now to Him who is able to do immeasurably more than all we ask or imagine, according to His power that is at work within us, be the glory throughout all generations, forever and ever. Amen”





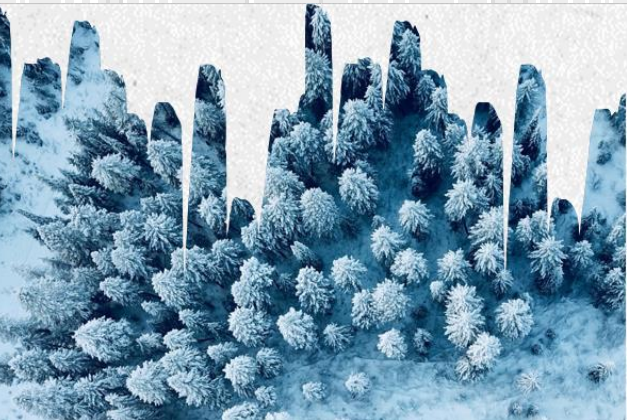
MARCH 20, 2022, HIGHER GLORY (Part 5)

What Should I Do to Make God Appear For Me as 'the Lord Almighty'?

Topic: PURSUE GOD'S PEACE ON YOUR LAND/LOT.

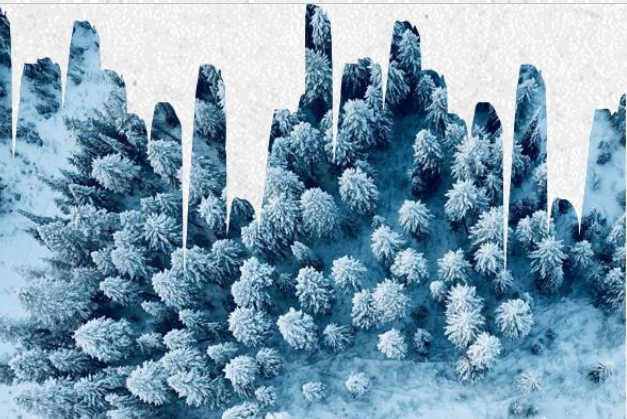
2 Thessalonians 3:16 "Now may the Lord of peace Himself give you peace at all times and in every way."

In 1 King 5, ² Solomon sent this message to Hiram the king of Tyre: ³ "You know that because of the wars waged against my father David from all sides, he could not build a temple for the Name of the LORD his God until the LORD put his enemies under his feet. ⁴ But now the LORD my God has given me rest on every side, and there is no adversary or disaster. ⁵ I intend, therefore, to build a temple for the Name of the LORD my God, as the LORD told my father David, when he said, 'Your son whom I will put on the throne in your place will build the temple for my Name.'"



Brethren, the wars are always against the allotted lot **BUT, with the coming of Jesus, victory has been established!**

- Speaking by the Holy Spirit, David himself declared: 'The Lord said to my Lord, "Sit at My right hand until I put Your enemies under Your feet."
(Mark 12:36; Psalm 110:1)
- "For the rod of the wicked shall not rest upon the land that has been allotted to the righteous; **lest the righteous put forth their hands to do iniquity** (or to do harm or wrong) **(Psalm 125:3)**
- David fought the battle himself and stained his hands with blood **BUT** No More shall we fight the battle, we will enjoy peace on every side so we can do God's work.
- In **1 Chronicles 28:3** "King David rose to his feet and said, "Listen to me, my brothers and my people. It was in my heart to build a house as a resting place for the ark of the covenant of the LORD and as a footstool for our God. I had made preparations to build it, **3but** God said to me, '**You are not to build a house for My Name, because you are a man of war who has spilled blood.**'



Brethren, David fought the battle himself and, thus, was not allowed to build the temple for God. His son Solomon, who enjoyed peace, built the temple.

And in **Psalms 110:1**, David said, when Jesus comes He will fight the battle and put all enemies under His feet.

This means that like Solomon, we are no longer expected to fight the battle, we should leverage the peace and build temple for God in our lot.

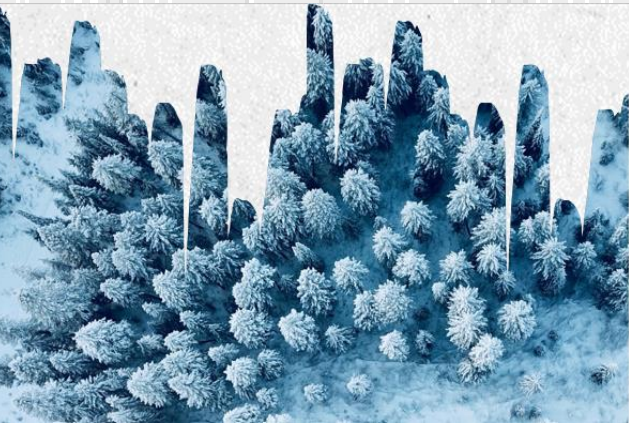
Revelations 19:11

John wrote, “In righteousness he judges and makes war” (Rev. 19:11).

John saw Jesus as the warrior King making war against His enemies and the enemies of his people.

John 16:33, Jesus said,

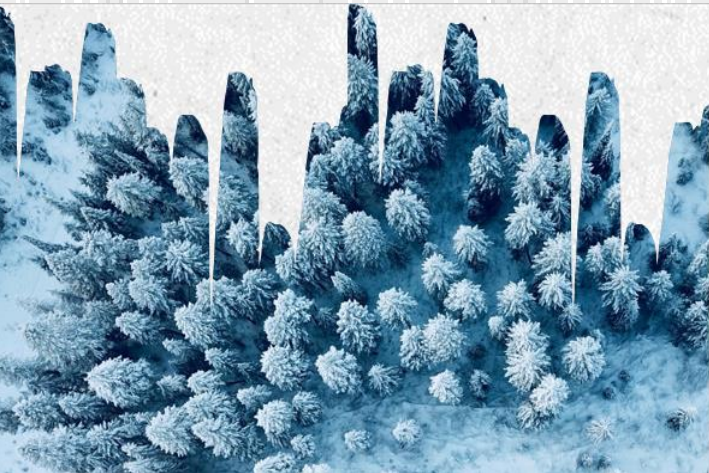
“I have told you these things, so that in me you may have peace. In this world you will have trouble. **But take heart! I have overcome the world.**”



WHAT IS THE IMPLICATION WHEN WE ARE TOLD TO PUESUE PEACE - *AND NOT WORRY ABOUT BATTLES?*

In John 14:27, Jesus said: “Peace I leave with you; My peace I give to you. I do not give to you as the world gives. Do not let **your hearts be troubled; do not be afraid.**”

1. Be righteous, hold on to Jesus and He will fight for you.
2. Do not let your hearts be troubled
3. Do not be afraid. Focus on the peace, not trouble (that seems to be)
4. Exercise faith: Like Solomon, start building God’s temple (what God has told you to build) on your lot. As you go, keep calling upon Jesus to proactively fight any battles along the way.
5. Take your authority: over the enemy, principalities and powers, spiritual wickedness in heavenly places, rulers of darkness of this world. **Cast them out to bottomless pit for eternity – never to return.**
6. Encourage yourself with your past testimonies. **David said**, I killed lions and bears, this philistine will be like one of them (**1 Sam 17:37**)
7. Command any trouble/oppositions you see or feel, to become snakes, cobra, scorpions, lions, beers, under your feet.



- **Jesus said, “I have given you authority to trample on snakes and scorpions and to overcome all the power of the enemy; nothing will harm you. 20**Nevertheless, do not rejoice that the spirits submit to you, but rejoice that your names are written in heaven.” **(Luke 10:19-20)**
- Based on his experience, **David said** “You will tread on the lion and cobra; you will trample the young lion and serpent. (Psalm 91:13) **Jesus said,** “I tell you the truth, if you have faith and don’t doubt, you can do things much more. You can even say to this mountain, ‘May you be lifted up and thrown into the sea,’ and it will happen. **(Matthew 21:21)**
- **Paul said,** “therefore, my beloved brothers, be steadfast, immovable (no fear), always abounding in the work of the Lord, knowing that in the Lord your labor is not in vain. (1 Corinthians 15:58)

Brethren, peace is already established on our lot! Let’s pursue that peace and steadfastly build a temple on our lot to God’s glory.
