# Exodus 19:4, God recounts how He has carried Israel on eagles' wings:

*4 'You yourselves have seen what I did to Egypt, and how I carried you on eagles' wings and brought you to myself.'*

*vs 5-6*

*“ 5 Now if you obey me fully and keep my covenant, then out of all nations you will be my treasured possession. Although the whole earth is mine, 6 you will be for Me a kingdom of priests and a holy nation.’*



# DRAW WATER FROM THE WELLS OF SALVATION

**Text” Isaiah 12:3: “With joy you will draw water from the wells of salvation.”**

Do we realize that our salvation is full of wells we can draw water from?

**Exodus 17:3-6** presents a people that were completely ignorant of this”

<sup>1</sup>The whole Israelite community set out from the Desert of Sin, ....They camped at Rephidim, but there was no water for the people to drink. <sup>2</sup> So they quarreled with Moses and said, “Give us water to drink.”. <sup>3</sup> ....“Why did you bring us up out of Egypt to make us and our children and livestock die of thirst?”. <sup>4</sup> Then Moses cried out to the LORD, “What am I to do with these people? They are almost ready to stone me.” <sup>5</sup> The LORD answered Moses, “Go out in front of the people. Take with you some of the elders of Israel and take in your hand the staff with which you struck the Nile, and go. <sup>6</sup> I will stand there before you by the rock at Horeb. Strike the rock, and water will come out of it for the people to drink.” So Moses did this in the sight of the elders of Israel.

**Brethren**, they did not realize that water was right there where they were standing. I can almost hear them saying (like Jacob said in **Genesis 28:16**) “Surely the LORD is in this place, and I was not aware of it.”

# DRAW WATER FROM THE WELLS OF SALVATION

Isaiah 12:3: “With joy you will draw water from the wells of salvation.”

Isaiah 12:3, tells us that the Salvation we have is full of wells we can draw water from.

Oil rich nations will tell you that they walk on some lands and they don't even realize that there is oil under they ground. And that is why you will her them say “we discovered oil”.

Just like Moses can now say, Oh, I struck the rock in the desert and discovered water, because he never new there was water there.

**Brethren**, any well that God establishes is filled with treasure. Therefore, the wells of Salvation are full of treasure. In **Philippians 2:12 bible tells us to “continue to work out your salvation with fear and trembling,”**

# DRAW WATER FROM THE WELLS OF SALVATION

**God said to Moses** (Exodus 17), <sup>6</sup> I will stand there before you by the rock at Horeb. Strike the rock, and water will come out of it for the people to drink.”

**Brethren, this is the simple principle to discovering each and everyone of your wells.** .... As you work out your salvation with fear and trembling, God will stand there before you, you will strike the rock with your staff and water will come forth and you can draw it with joy.

When David, discovered this principle, he said, God, “You will show me the path of life; In Your presence is fullness of joy; (Psalm 16:11).

David realized that once God stands with you will have access to well of access to water and supply.

The **second** principle we note is that Moses asked God and the **third** is that God said, I will stand before you **BUT** “you will strike the rock with the staff in your hands”, It means we need staff in our hands to draw waters from our well.

**James 2:17** ““faith by itself, if it does not result in action, is dead.”

# DRAW WATER FROM THE WELLS OF SALVATION

**The number of wells and even size of each well are not the same for all children of God**

What you get depends on how you are working with the Holy Spirit: Our:

1. Zeal and commitment (zealous about the things of God)
2. Diligence (Diligent hand will rule)
3. How far we see (As far as you can see) I God gave testimony “have found David the son of Jesse, a man after mine own heart” (Acts 13:22)
4. How much we lap the word of God

**James 4:8** “Draw near to God and He will draw near to you.”

**Exodus 17:6** “<sup>4</sup> Then Moses cried out to the LORD, “What am I to do with these people?”

**Joshua 1:8** “<sup>8</sup> Keep this Book of the Law always on your lips; meditate on it day and night, so that you may be careful to do everything written in it. Then you will be prosperous and successful.

**Once we are working within the conditions and principles of wells, we can continue to increase the number of wells and the size of each well limitlessly.**

**The danger is that some Christians ignorantly set a limit on themselves. You could do so much more for God on earth but you pack-up so quickly and limited yourself.**



# DRAW WATER FROM THE WELLS OF SALVATION

**2 Kings 4** present the story of a widow of who drew water (oil) from her well of salvation; however, she ignorantly set a limit on her herself.

**“The wife of a man from the company of the prophets” “The wife of a man from the company of the prophets cried out to Elisha, “Your servant my husband is dead, and you know that he revered the LORD.”**

*( ..... Elisha is her witness that the power of God is already in her house (principle #1)*

**“But now his creditor is coming to take my two boys as his slaves.”**

**2 Elisha replied to her, “How can I help you? Tell me, what do you have in your house?”**

**“Your servant has nothing there at all,” she said, “except a small jar of olive oil.”**

*(..... The woman had to ask and she had to make sure there is staff in her hand (Principle #2))*

**“<sup>3</sup> Elisha said, “Go around and ask all your neighbors for empty jars. Don’t ask for just a few. <sup>4</sup> Then go inside and shut the door behind you and your sons. Pour oil into all the jars, and as each is filled, put it to one side.”**

*(.... The woman had to do the task using the staff in her hand (Principle #3).*



# DRAW WATER FROM THE WELLS OF SALVATION

**Elisha said** “Don’t ask for just a few.” (*..... Do not set a limit on yourself. You can draw water from this well limitlessly. Some people have big well but few empty jars*)

**<sup>5</sup> She left him and shut the door behind her and her sons. They brought the jars to her and she kept pouring. <sup>6</sup> When all the jars were full, she said to her son, “Bring me another one.” But he replied, “There is not a jar left.” Then the oil stopped flowing.**

**<sup>7</sup> She went and told the man of God, and he said, “Go, sell the oil and pay your debts. You and your sons can live on what is left.”**

## CONCLUSION

**The Danger:** When we pack up as Christians, the oil stops flowing.

If you have packed up on a well. Please quickly ask God to show you another well. **Our salvation has capacity for many wells, once we are following the conditions and principles of wells.**

**Brethren,** let us go and draw water from the wells of our salvation. **God Bless You!**
