Psalm 23: 1-6

**God is our shepherd,
He will position us and
make our cup overflow.**

Exodus 19:4

**God will carry us on
eagles' wings, no
matter what comes up.**

Ecclesiastes 12:13

**Our only role is to fear
God, listen to the Holy
Spirit, in us, and obey
His command.**

Exodus 19:4, God recounts how He carried Israel on eagles' wings:

4 'You yourselves have seen what I did to Egypt, and how I carried you on eagles' wings and brought you to myself.'

vs 5-6

“ 5 Now if you obey me fully and keep my covenant, then out of all nations you will be my treasured possession. Although the whole earth is mine, 6 you will be for Me a kingdom of priests and a holy nation.’

What did God do for the Israelites?

First: the promise: *Exodus 3: 7-8 (AMP)*

⁷The LORD said to Moses, “I have in fact seen the affliction (suffering, desolation) of My people who are in Egypt, and have heard their cry because of their taskmasters (oppressors); for I know their pain and suffering. ⁸So I have come down to rescue them from the hand (power) of the Egyptians, and to bring them up from that land to a land [that is] good and spacious, to a land flowing with milk and honey [a land of plenty]—to the place of the Canaanite, the Hittite, the Amorite, the Perizzite, the Hivite, and the Jebusite.

Exodus 6: 4 “⁴I also established covenant with Abraham, Isaac and Jacob to give them the land of Canaan, where they resided as foreigners.”

Second: the actions for fulfilment (journeying to Canaan) – carrying them on eagles’ wings:

- The exodus out of Egypt after 430 years in slavery/bondage: Exodus 12:31-50
- God brought Israelites out of Egypt with a mighty hand (**Daniel 9:15**)
- Crossing the red sea & killing the Egyptians without their efforts Exodus 14:1-31
- Leading Israel through the wilderness: Exodus 15:22 – Ex 18 (bitter water became sweet, manna & quail from heaven, water from the rock, etc.)

Third: the request to stay SANCTIFIED/OBEDIENT in order to become God’s special ones : Exodus 19:5-6

“⁵ Now if you obey me **fully** and keep my covenant, **then out of all nations** you will be my treasured possession. Although the whole earth is mine, ⁶ you will be for me a kingdom of priests and a holy nation.’”

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We will look at two dimensions of thought:

Dimension 1: The problem has lingered for too long, God cannot come in now and solve it.

Dimension 2: If God will punish for 40 years, then the person cannot make it to the promised land.

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Dimension 1:

Problem has lingered for too long, God cannot come in now and solve it.

Brethren, **IT DOES NOT MATTER! THE TIME HAS COME!** This is the difference between an ordinary miracle and God stepping in to carry you on eagles' wings. **He has come to deal with all old lingering problems.**

Children of Israel had been in slavery for 430 years.

- They were God's people.
- They were suffering.
- God knew they were suffering.
- They had been crying to God to help them.
- Yet, God kept silent until the 430th year, and then He said to Moses: "I have in fact seen the suffering of My people, and I have heard their cry; for I know their pain and suffering. ⁸ So I have come down to rescue them"

God used their suffering to show Pharaoh His power. And used the waiting time to prepare them for the promised land.

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For every problem, God sets the expiry date based on His own agenda.

In Jeremiah 1:5, God said to Jeremiah “Before I formed you in the womb I knew you, before you were born I set you apart; I appointed you as a prophet to the nations.”...

⁹ Then the LORD reached out his hand and touched my mouth and said to me, “I have put my words in your mouth. ¹⁰ See, today I appoint you over nations and kingdoms to uproot and tear down, to destroy and overthrow, to build and to plant.”

¹¹ The word of the LORD came to me: “What do you see, Jeremiah?” “I see the branch of an almond tree,” I replied. ¹² The LORD said to me, “You have seen correctly, for I am watching^[b] to see that my word is fulfilled.”

God has a role for every believer, He has a pathway to take for each person and He equips us to get the job done according to His plan. He watches to see how we are doing it.

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Jeremiah 29:11-14 “For I know the **thoughts** that I **think** toward **you**, says the **LORD**, **thoughts** of peace and not of evil, to give **you** a future and a hope.”
God’s equipping does not happen at once. That is why we must SEEK Him consistently for direction and strategies. If we don’t, He will compel us to camp and depending on what He sees, that camping time may be long or short.

In James 1, these camping moments are called “humble circumstances”:

⁹Believers in humble circumstances ought to take pride in their high position.....¹² Blessed is the one who perseveres under trial because, having stood the test, that person will receive the crown of life that the Lord has promised to those who love him.

¹⁶ Don’t be deceived, my dear brothers and sisters. ¹⁷ Every good and perfect gift is from above, coming down from the Father of the heavenly lights, who does not change like shifting shadows

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The tools God used to deliver the children have been there years before the deliverance.

- Moses was eighty years old and Aaron eighty-three when they spoke to Pharaoh.
- The staff in Moses' hands has been with him for as he tended the flocks
- But God had set a time on how long they will be in Egypt based on whom He has seen they are and where is taking them to.
- **If God sees that by blessing us we will fall out of faith, then He will wait.**

But no matter how long we are in the humble circumstance, when God is ready, He will get us out with a Mighty hand and carry us on eagles wings.

- God brought Israelites out of Egypt with a mighty hand (**Daniel 9:15**)
- Jesus was in the grave for 3 days, *suddenly there was a great earthquake! For an angel of the Lord came down from heaven, rolled aside the stone, and sat on it.* (Matth. 2:2).
- *Lazarus was in the grave for 4 days, Jesus cried out in a loud voice, "Lazarus, come forth!"* (John 11:43).
- *Jonah was 3 days in the belly of a fish and when the day came for deliverance, "the LORD commanded the fish, and it vomited Jonah onto dry land"* (Jonah 2:10)

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Dimension 2: If God will punish for 40 years, then the person cannot make it to the promised land.

Brethren,

Joshua was the servant of Moses and he wondered for the 40 years in wilderness and yet led children of Israel to the promised land.

- **Caleb in Joshua 14:7** *“I was forty years old when Moses the servant of the LORD sent me from Kadesh-barnea to spy out the land, and I brought him word again as it was in my heart.”*
- *I am this day, eighty-five years old. ¹¹ As yet I am as strong this day as on the day that Moses sent me; just as my strength was then, so now is my strength for war, both for going out and for coming in. ¹² Now therefore, give me this mountain of which the LORD spoke in that day;*

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Conclusion

Brethren, no matter where we are on our journey, it is not late to get on the eagles' wings. And God will deliver us with His mighty hands
