#### 2024 Important Broad Promises Revealed

Psalm 23: 1-6

God is our shaphard

God is our shepherd, He will position us and make our cup overflow. Exodus 19:4

God will carry us on eagles' wings, no matter what comes up.

Ecclesiastes 12:13

Our only role is to fear God, listen to the Holy Spirit, in us, and obey His command.

# Exodus 19:4, God recounts how He has carried Israel on eagles' wings:

4 'You yourselves have seen what I did to Egypt, and how I carried you on eagles' wings and brought you to myself'.

VS 5-6

" <sup>5</sup> Now if you obey me fully and keep my covenant, then out of all nations you will be my treasured possession. Although the whole earth is mine, <sup>6</sup> you will be for Me a kingdom of priests and a holy nation."

#### What did God do for the Israelites?

First: the promise: Exodus 3: 7-8 (AMP and NIV)

<sup>7</sup> The LORD said to Moses, "I have in fact <u>seen</u> the affliction (suffering, desolation) of My people who are in Egypt, and have <u>heard</u> their cry because of their taskmasters (oppressors); for I <u>know</u> their pain and suffering." "<sup>8</sup> So I have come down to rescue them from the hand of the Egyptians and to bring them up out of that land into a good and spacious land, a land flowing with milk and honey—the home of the Canaanites, Hittites, Amorites, Perizzites, Hivites and Jebusites".

**Exodus 6: 4** "4I also established covenant with Abraham, Isaac and Jacob to give them the land of Canaan, where they resided as foreigners."

**Second**: the actions for fulfilment of promise (journeying to Canaan) – carrying them on eagles' wings:

- The exodus out of Egypt after 430years in slavery/bondage: Exodus 12:31-50... they left with silver/gold
- God brought Israelites out of Egypt with a mighty hand (Daniel 9:15)
- Crossing the red sea & killing the Egyptians without Israel's efforts Exodus 14:1-31
- Leading Israel through the wilderness: Exodus 15:22 Ex 18 (bitter water became sweet, manna & quail from heaven, water from the rock, etc.)

**Third**: the request to stay SANCTIFIED/OBEDIENT in order to become God's special ones: Exodus 19:5-6 " <sup>5</sup> Now if you obey me **fully** and keep my covenant, **then out of all nations** you will be my treasured possession. Although the whole earth is mine, <sup>6</sup> you will be for me a kingdom of priests and a holy nation.'

June 02, we were reminded that: Eagles are resilient

**June 09**, we were reminded that God makes a distinction between Egypt and Israel. He makes those who are His soar instead of fly

Today, June 23, we are reminded that: God Shows Up.

#### **GOD SHOWS UP.**

**Luke 10:3:** "Go your way; behold, I am sending you out as lambs in the midst of wolves."

**John 15:19** "The world would love you as one of its own if you belonged to it, but you are no longer part of the world. I chose you to come out of the world, so it hates you.

2 Corinthians 5:17 "Therefore, if anyone is in Christ, he is a new creation. The old has passed away; behold, the new has come"

This new creation can be exemplified with what was seen in transfiguration:

**Transfiguration** (Mark 9:2–13; Matthew 17:1–13; Luke 9:28–36)

If people were told that the form that Jesus took on earth was different from His real form, they would have doubted. God used the transfiguration experience to bring out the truth. The word 'transfiguration' means a change of form or appearance. In this passage Jesus' appearance changes to show a glimpse of His full heavenly glory, which was normally veiled during Christ's life on earth. "His face shone like the sun and his clothes became as white as the light".

In a similar way, once we are saved, our form changes but we are still live within the world.

In John 17, Jesus prayed "<sup>13</sup>" I am coming to you now, but I say these: "things while I am still in the world, so that they may have the full measure of my joy within them. <sup>14</sup> I have given them your word and the world has hated them, for they are not of the world any more than I am of the world. <sup>15</sup> My prayer is not that you take them out of the world but that you protect them from the evil one. <sup>16</sup> They are not of the world, even as I am not of it. <sup>17</sup> Sanctify them by <sup>[d]</sup> the truth; your word is truth. <sup>18</sup> As you sent me into the world, I have sent them into the world. <sup>19</sup> For them I sanctify myself, that they too may be truly sanctified.

**Therefore,** we are required to understand that though we are in the world, we are no longer of the world.

So, we must be Spiritually minded.

2 Timothy 2:4 says: "Soldiers don't get tied up in the affairs of civilian life, for then they cannot please the officer who enlisted them."

Colossian 2:8 says: "See to it that no one takes you captive through hollow and deceptive philosophy, which depends on human tradition and the elemental spiritual forces of this world rather than on Christ."

Jesus is the second in the Trinity, He always revered to the Father (God Himself). In His time Holy Ghost was not in the world, so Jesus always looked up.

#### Each time Jesus looked up, God showed Up.

**Example John 11:41** "So they took away the stone. And Jesus raised His eyes [toward heaven] and said, "Father, I thank You that You have heard Me."

How does it happen with us?

John 4:24 says "God is spirit, and His worshipers must worship in the Spirit and in truth."

John 16: 12-13 Jesus said to His disciples "12 I have much more to say to you, more than you can now bear. 13 When the Spirit of truth comes, He will guide you into all the truth, for He will not speak on His own authority, but whatever He hears He will speak, and He will declare to you the things that are to come." "14 He will glorify me because it is from me that He will receive what he will make known to you (there is an order). 15 All that belongs to the Father is mine. That is why I said the Spirit will receive from me what He will make known to you."

- So, to connect with God, we must see things with our spiritual eyes (not carnal eyes) and then connect with the Holy Ghost (who is Spirit) who leads us unto all truths.
- Brethren, our human capacity cannot retain the actual quantum of knowledge, wisdom and discernment we need to conquer our land. They are stored up in the spirit.

Romans 8: 6-7 "6 to be carnally minded is death; but to be spiritually minded is life and

peace. <sup>7</sup> Because the carnal mind is enmity against God: for it is not subject to the law of God, neither indeed can be.

Romans 8: 14 "For those who are led by the Spirit of God are the children of God."

The laws of God make it possible for a thing to be declared and it comes to pass. And these all happen in the spirit.

#### Brethren, God encouraged us:

**Isaiah 41:10 :** Fear not, for I am with you; be not dismayed, for I am your God; I will strengthen you, I will help you, I will uphold you with my righteous right hand.

**Joshua 1:9:** Have I not commanded you? Be strong and courageous. Do not be frightened, and do not be dismayed, for the LORD your God is with you wherever you go."

**Deuteronomy 31:8:** It is the LORD who goes before you. He will be with you; he will not leave you or forsake you. Do not fear or be dismayed."

Matthew 28:20: Behold, I am with you always, to the end of the age."

Deuteronomy 31:6: I will not leave you or forsake you."

**Joshua 1:5:** No man shall be able to stand before you all the days of your life. Just as I was with Moses, so I will be with you. I will not leave you or forsake you.

**Brethren**, while we are in the world moving physically, the Trinity is moving along with us in the Spirit. And once we connect spiritually, God shows up for us.

#### **Examples:**

1. Moses and the burning bush (Exodus 3)

Moses led the flock to the <u>far side</u> of the wilderness and came to Horeb, the mountain of God. <sup>2</sup> There the angel of the LORD appeared to him in flames of fire from within a bush. Moses saw that though the bush was on fire it did not burn up. <sup>3</sup> So Moses thought, "I will go over and see this strange sight—why the bush does not burn up." <sup>4</sup> When the LORD saw that he had gone over to look, (God showed up) God called to him from within the bush, "Moses! Moses!"

#### 2. Moses and Israelites standing on the same spot (Exodus 14)

When Pharaoh drew near, the children of Israel lifted their eyes, and behold, the Egyptians marched after them. So they were very afraid, and the children of Israel cried out to the LORD. <sup>11</sup> Then they said to Moses, "Because there were no graves in Egypt, have you taken us away to die in the wilderness? ....<sup>13</sup> And Moses said to the people, "Do not be afraid. Stand still, and see the salvation of the LORD, which He will accomplish for you today. For the Egyptians whom you see today, you shall see again no more forever. <sup>14</sup> The LORD will fight for you, and you shall hold<sup>[c]</sup> your peace."

#### When God saw a faith that understood and connected with the spirit, God showed up.

<sup>15</sup> And the LORD said to Moses, "Why do you cry to Me? Tell the children of Israel to go forward. <sup>16</sup> But lift up your rod, and stretch out your hand over the sea and divide it. And the children of Israel shall go on dry *ground* through the midst of the sea.

3. Throughout out the journey that Moses was leading them, the same spot that God did not show up for the children of Israel, God showed up for Moses and brought manner, quail for meat, water from rock

- **4. David: 1 Samuel 17:36-37** "<sup>36</sup>Your servant has killed both the lion and the bear;, "The LORD, who delivered me from the claws of the lion and the bear, will deliver me from the hand of this Philistine." And with a stone and sling, he killed Goliath"
- 5. We know how God showed up in the burning furnace, lions' den, etc.
- **6. After resurrection (Luke 24):** <sup>13</sup> Now that same day two of them (the disciples) were going to a village called Emmaus, about seven miles from Jerusalem. <sup>14</sup> They were talking with each other about everything that had happened. <sup>15</sup> As they talked and discussed these things with each other, Jesus himself came up and walked along with them; <sup>16</sup> **but they were kept from recognizing him**. <sup>17</sup> He asked them, "What are you discussing together as you walk along?" **God is the silent listener to every conversation.**
- 7. Some testimonials: God showed up for a brother on his way to a camp ground, God showed up for a Sister who had travelled to the USA for a business trip in the middle of a 40days self-declared fast.

**CONCLUSION**: Brethren, **God Shows Up**. Let us continue to dig deeper in the spirit and not fear.
