2024 Important Broad Promises Revealed

Psalm 23: 1-6

**God is our shepherd,
He will position us and
make our cup overflow.**

Exodus 19:4

**God will carry us on
eagles' wings, no
matter what comes up.**

Ecclesiastes 12:13

**Our only role is to fear
God, listen to the Holy
Spirit, in us, and obey
His command.**

Exodus 19:4, God recounts how He has carried Israel on eagles' wings:

4 'You yourselves have seen what I did to Egypt, and how I carried you on eagles' wings and brought you to myself.'

vs 5-6

'5 Now if you obey me fully and keep my covenant, then out of all nations you will be my treasured possession. Although the whole earth is mine, 6 you will be for Me a kingdom of priests and a holy nation.'

What did God do for the Israelites?

First: the promise: *Exodus 3: 7-8 (AMP and NIV)*

⁷ The LORD said to Moses, “I have in fact seen the affliction (suffering, desolation) of My people who are in Egypt, and have heard their cry because of their taskmasters (oppressors); for I know their pain and suffering.” ⁸ So I have come down to rescue them from the hand of the Egyptians and to bring them up out of that land into a good and spacious land, a land flowing with milk and honey—the home of the Canaanites, Hittites, Amorites, Perizzites, Hivites and Jebusites”.

Exodus 6: 4 “⁴I also established covenant with Abraham, Isaac and Jacob to give them the land of Canaan, where they resided as foreigners.”

Second: the actions for fulfilment of promise (journeying to Canaan) – carrying them on eagles’ wings:

- The exodus out of Egypt after 430 years in slavery/bondage: Exodus 12:31-50... they left with silver/gold
- God brought Israelites out of Egypt with a mighty hand (**Daniel 9:15**)
- Crossing the red sea & killing the Egyptians without Israel’s efforts Exodus 14:1-31
- Leading Israel through the wilderness: Exodus 15:22 – Ex 18 (bitter water became sweet, manna & quail from heaven, water from the rock, etc.)

Third: the request to stay SANCTIFIED/OBEDIENT in order to become God’s special ones : Exodus 19:5-6

“⁵ Now if you obey me **fully** and keep my covenant, **then out of all nations** you will be my treasured possession. Although the whole earth is mine, ⁶ you will be for me a kingdom of priests and a holy nation.’

Exodus 11:7 “you will know that the LORD makes a distinction between Egypt and Israel.”

God sent Moses to inform Pharaoh that He will kill every first born in Egypt but none of Israel's children will be affected..

Exodus 11:

⁴ So Moses said, “This is what the LORD says: ‘About midnight I will go throughout Egypt. ⁵ Every firstborn son in Egypt will die, from the firstborn son of Pharaoh, who sits on the throne, to the firstborn son of the female slave, who is at her hand mill, and all the firstborn of the cattle as well. ⁶ There will be loud wailing throughout Egypt—worse than there has ever been or ever will be again. ⁷ But among the Israelites not a dog will bark at any person or animal.’ **Then you will know that the LORD makes a distinction between Egypt and Israel.**

Exodus 9 says that even with plague on livestock, God made a distinction between the livestock of Egypt and that of Israel.

Exodus 9:4 “⁴ the LORD will make a distinction between the livestock of Israel and that of Egypt.”

Exodus 9:1-5,

¹ Then the LORD said to Moses, “Go to Pharaoh and say to him, ‘This is what the LORD, the God of the Hebrews, says: “Let my people go, so that they may worship me.” ² If you refuse to let them go and continue to hold them back, ³ the hand of the LORD will bring a terrible plague on your livestock in the field—on your horses, donkeys and camels and on your cattle, sheep and goats. ⁴ But the LORD will make a distinction between the livestock of Israel and that of Egypt, so that no animal belonging to the Israelites will die.’”

Brethren, making a distinction between Egypt and Israel is what God has always done and He is still doing today.

This is why it is so crucial for us to stand strong as Christians on the side of God because He will always make a distinction between His own and others.

And even among His children (His own), “He is a rewarder of those who diligently seek Him (Hebrews 11:6)

In Isaiah 40:31 bible says, “those who hope in the LORD will soar on wings like eagles” (NIV)

Dictionary clarifies the difference between soaring and flying:

To soar means more than just to fly; it means to rise swiftly and glide effortlessly at very high altitudes. To feel the wind slipping below you as you ride higher, higher, higher without your own effort.

Flying, however, is defined as sustained and controlled movement through the air using power and efforts.

It doesn't take eagles much strength to soar around or gain altitude. Infact, instead of using their own strength, they use the strong winds to their advantage. They don't need to flap their wings, eagles keep their wings steady, and move only their tail.

Eagles mainly fly when they descend or are pursuing a prey.
They fly as an eagle that hurries to devour (Habakkuk 1:8)

Brethren, as children of God, let us live life that enables us to fully access the privileges that accrue to Israel so that God can make us soar like eagle while He does the work for us;

In Exodus 14:13-14,¹³ Moses answered the people, "Do not be afraid. Stand firm and you will see the deliverance the LORD will bring you today. The Egyptians you see today you will never see again. ¹⁴ The LORD will fight for you; you need only to be still." ... *Moses was there to get the privileges for the Israelites.*

2 Chronicles 20:15,. The LORD said: 'Be not afraid or dismayed at this great multitude, for the battle is not yours, but God's

Psalm 104:3-4

He lays the beams of His chambers on the waters; He makes the clouds His chariot; He rides on the wings of the wind; He makes his messengers winds, His ministers a flaming fire.

.... I believe we would like to be flaming fire. Then let's be ministers of God.

Isaiah 58:14

If you take delight in the LORD, I will make you ride on the heights of the earth.

Deuteronomy 33:26

“There is none like God, He rides through the heavens to your help, through the skies in his majesty.

³ Join with me in suffering, like a good soldier of Christ Jesus. ⁴ No one serving as a soldier gets entangled in civilian affairs, but rather tries to please his commanding officer. ⁵ Similarly, anyone who competes as an athlete does not receive the victor's crown except by competing according to the rules. ⁶ The hardworking farmer should be the first to receive a share of the crops. ⁷ Reflect on what I am saying, for the Lord will give you insight into all this.

Brethren, let us go and exhibit the character of a good soldier in service, an athlete competing to win and a hardworking farmer that deserves the first share of the crops. God Almighty will distinguish us and enable us to soar like the eagle while He does the work on our behalf.
