ON EAGLES' WINGS Exodus 19:4

ONE IS GOOD BUT TWO ARE BETTER.

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2024 Important Broad Promises Revealed

Psalm 23: 1-6

God is our shophard

God is our shepherd, He will position us and make our cup overflow. Exodus 19:4

God will carry us on eagles' wings, no matter what comes up.

Ecclesiastes 12:13

Our only role is to fear God, listen to the Holy Spirit, in us, and obey His command.

Exodus 19:4, God recounts how He has carried Israel on eagles' wings:

4 'You yourselves have seen what I did to Egypt, and how I carried you on eagles' wings and brought you to myself'.

VS 5-6

" ⁵ Now if you obey me fully and keep my covenant, then out of all nations you will be my treasured possession. Although the whole earth is mine, ⁶ you will be for Me a kingdom of priests and a holy nation."

What did God do for the Israelites?

First: the promise: Exodus 3: 7-8 (AMP and NIV)

⁷ The LORD said to Moses, "I have in fact <u>seen</u> the affliction (suffering, desolation) of My people who are in Egypt, and have <u>heard</u> their cry because of their taskmasters (oppressors); for I <u>know</u> their pain and suffering." "⁸ So I have come down to rescue them from the hand of the Egyptians and to bring them up out of that land into a good and spacious land, a land flowing with milk and honey—the home of the Canaanites, Hittites, Amorites, Perizzites, Hivites and Jebusites".

Exodus 6: 4 "4I also established covenant with Abraham, Isaac and Jacob to give them the land of Canaan, where they resided as foreigners."

Second: the actions for fulfilment of promise (journeying to Canaan) – carrying them on eagles' wings:

- The exodus out of Egypt after 430years in slavery/bondage: Exodus 12:31-50... they left with silver/gold
- God brought Israelites out of Egypt with a mighty hand (Daniel 9:15)
- Crossing the red sea & killing the Egyptians without Israel's efforts Exodus 14:1-31
- Leading Israel through the wilderness: Exodus 15:22 Ex 18 (bitter water became sweet, manna & quail from heaven, water from the rock, etc.)

Third: the request to stay SANCTIFIED/OBEDIENT in order to become God's special ones: Exodus 19:5-6 " ⁵ Now if you obey me **fully** and keep my covenant, **then out of all nations** you will be my treasured possession. Although the whole earth is mine, ⁶ you will be for me a kingdom of priests and a holy nation.'

One is good but two are better.

For example:

James 5:16 says "When a good person prays to God, God does powerful things."

Isaiah 3:10-12 "Reassure the righteous that their good living will pay off."

However, two are better!

For example:

Deuteronomy 32:30

"How can one man pursue a thousand, and two put ten thousand to flight."

2 Corinthians 13:1 "By the mouth of two or three witnesses every word shall be established."

Matthew 18:20 "20 For where two or three gather in my name, there am I with them."

The Implication,

There is an extra power that comes with two.

This is why God prefers never to let us walk alone.

There are 3 persons in one God:

- God the Father
- God the Son
- God the Holy Spirit

Although each of them can act as God, yet because God knew that more results would be achieved when there are two, He sent the Holy Spirit to Jesus (Acts 10:38):

Acts 10:38 "God anointed Jesus of Nazareth with the Holy Spirit and with power, and He went about doing good and healing all who were oppressed by the devil, for God was with Him."

When you are two, 3-things happen:

- 1. You achieve more results
- 2. The load is lighter for you
- 3. You meet the condition for God to join you:
- "Where 2 or more are gathered, there I am" (Matthew 18:20)
- "for God was with Him" as soon as the Holy Spirit joined Jesus (Acts 10:38)

In Mark 6:7-13, understanding the power of two, before the Holy Spirit was sent to the disciples, Jesus sent them out in two's:

"And He called the twelve and began to send them out **two by two**, and gave them authority over the unclean spirits....¹³ And they cast out many demons and anointed with oil many who were sick and healed them.(there is Power in two's).

In John 14:15-17, Jesus said to His disciples"

¹⁵ "If you love me, keep my commands. ¹⁶ And I will ask the Father, and He will give you another advocate to help you and be with you forever — ¹⁷ the Spirit of truth."… ²³ …"Anyone who loves me will obey my teaching. My Father will love them, and we will come to them and make our home with them.

- Jesus understood the Power of two.
- Jesus knew that the second person comes to help you (make your load lighter)
- You will achieve more results

Brethren, the privilege of getting a helper is for those who "love Him, and will keep His commands".

John 14:17: talking about the Holy Spirit, Jesus said ¹⁷ the Spirit of truth. The world cannot accept Him, because it neither sees Him nor knows Him. But you know Him, for He lives with you and **will be in you**.

In Luke 24:49, Jesus said to the disciples:

⁴⁹ Listen carefully: I am sending the Promise of My Father [the Holy Spirit] upon you; but you are to remain in the city [of Jerusalem] until you are clothed (fully equipped) with power from on high."

⁵⁰ Then He led them out as far as Bethany, and lifted up His hands and blessed them. ⁵¹ While He was blessing them, He left them and was taken up into heaven.

Brethren, these people are disciples, each one can function alone and achieve some results. Yet Jesus said to them Listen, stay in the city until you are clothed.

Acts 2:1-13: ¹When the day of Pentecost came, they were all together in one place..... ⁴All of them were filled with the Holy Spirit and began to speak in other tongues as the Spirit enabled them.

Brethren, Now filled with the Holy Spirit, each of them has become two and power came upon each of the disciples. **Suddenly**, Peter who even denied Jesus, stood up and preached immediately and 3,000 people were saved **(Acts 2:41).**

Conclusion

Brethren, One Is Good But Two Are Better!

We need the Holy Spirit, the Helper, to achieve significant results for God.

We achieve more when we walk and work with the Holy Spirit.

Isaiah 11:2 describes the Holy Spirit's job:

"The Spirit of the LORD IS ———

the Spirit of wisdom and of understanding,

the Spirit of counsel and of power,

the Spirit of the knowledge and fear of the LORD"

What does it mean to walk & work with Him? Sit on the table with Him, talk with Him, plan with Him, talk with Him before you start any task, ask Him for clarification at difficult moments, review the results with Him to be sure they are complete.
