# 2024 Important Broad Promises Revealed

Psalm 23: 1-6

Cod is our shophord

God is our shepherd, He will position us and make our cup overflow. Exodus 19:4

God will carry us on eagles' wings, no matter what comes up.

Ecclesiastes 12:13

Our only role is to fear God, listen to the Holy Spirit, in us, and obey His command.

# Exodus 19:4, God recounts how He has carried Israel on eagles' wings:

4 'You yourselves have seen what I did to Egypt, and how I carried you on eagles' wings and brought you to myself'.

VS 5-6

" <sup>5</sup> Now if you obey me fully and keep my covenant, then out of all nations you will be my treasured possession. Although the whole earth is mine, <sup>6</sup> you will be for Me a kingdom of priests and a holy nation."

## What did God do for the Israelites?

First: the promise: Exodus 3: 7-8 (AMP and NIV)

<sup>7</sup> The LORD said to Moses, "I have in fact <u>seen</u> the affliction (suffering, desolation) of My people who are in Egypt, and have <u>heard</u> their cry because of their taskmasters (oppressors); for I <u>know</u> their pain and suffering." "<sup>8</sup> So I have come down to rescue them from the hand of the Egyptians and to bring them up out of that land into a good and spacious land, a land flowing with milk and honey—the home of the Canaanites, Hittites, Amorites, Perizzites, Hivites and Jebusites".

**Exodus 6: 4** "4I also established covenant with Abraham, Isaac and Jacob to give them the land of Canaan, where they resided as foreigners."

**Second**: the actions for fulfilment of promise (journeying to Canaan) – carrying them on eagles' wings:

- The exodus out of Egypt after 430years in slavery/bondage: Exodus 12:31-50... they left with silver/gold
- God brought Israelites out of Egypt with a mighty hand (Daniel 9:15)
- Crossing the red sea & killing the Egyptians without Israel's efforts Exodus 14:1-31
- Leading Israel through the wilderness: Exodus 15:22 Ex 18 (bitter water became sweet, manna & quail from heaven, water from the rock, etc.)

**Third**: the request to stay SANCTIFIED/OBEDIENT in order to become God's special ones: Exodus 19:5-6 " <sup>5</sup> Now if you obey me <u>fully</u> and keep my covenant, <u>then out of all nations</u> you will be my treasured possession. Although the whole earth is mine, <sup>6</sup> you will be for me a kingdom of priests and a holy nation.'

# Text: Isaiah 45:1-3 (NIV)

1"This is what the LORD says to His anointed, to Cyrus, whose right hand I take hold of, to subdue nations before him and to strip kings of their armor, to open doors before him so that gates will not be shut:

<sup>2</sup> I will go before you and will level the mountains<sup>1</sup>; I will break down gates of bronze and cut through bars of iron.

<sup>3</sup> I will give you hidden treasures, riches stored in secret places, so that you may know that I am the LORD, the God of Israel, who summons you by name.

Brethren, God has called us unto His wings and recognized us as anointed ones.

Part 1 & 2 focused on verses 1 & 2; Today is on privilege of the anointed in verse 3.

V3: "3 I will give you hidden treasures, riches stored in secret places, so that you may know that I am the LORD, the God of Israel, who summons you by name."

(Cross reference to KCM message of April 19th, 2015, on 'Treasure in Jars of Clay')

Brethren, God is very protective of His treasure and His secret. He releases them to people He can trust; people He can confide in.

In Psalm 25:14, bible says that "The secret of the LORD is for those who fear Him, And He will make them know His covenant."

God is willing to give us "hidden treasures, riches stored in secret places" in the world, however, He starts by first evaluating how we have handled the treasure that He has deposited in us.

2 Corinthians 4:6-7 says: "<sup>6</sup> God, …" made His light shine in our hearts to give us the light of the knowledge of God's glory (treasure) displayed in the face of Christ. <sup>7</sup> But we have this treasure in jars of clay to show that this all-surpassing power is from God and not from us.

Though our mortal body is clay, it has been made into a JAR so that it can house Treasure (God's WORD, God's GLORY, God's POWER and our TESTIMONIES).

While we are nothing (clay) God put His power (treasure) in us to act powerfully. It is not by our power or our might but by the Spirit (Zachariah 4:6)

2 Peter 1: <sup>3</sup>"His divine power has granted to us all things that pertain to life and godliness, through the knowledge of Him who called us to His own glory and excellence"

It is, therefore, God's divine power that connects us to treasures in the physical.

#### There is a reason that the bible says in Proverbs 27:17-18 that

"17 iron sharpens iron,....<sup>18</sup> The one who guards a fig tree will eat its fruit, and whoever protects their master will be honored."

As believer, we should practically demonstrate that we can handle the treasure within us, so that God will be confident to allow us handle the ones outside.

The ability to see and nurture the treasure within us is the distinction between believers and unbelievers.

2 Corinthians 4:4 says concerning unbelievers, <sup>4</sup> The god of this age has blinded the minds of unbelievers, so that they cannot see the light of the gospel that displays the glory (treasure) of Christ, who is the image of God.

It means unbelievers cannot see and nurture the treasure within them.

**But for believers,** "<sup>6</sup> God, …" made His light shine in our hearts to give us the light of the knowledge of God's glory (treasure) displayed in the face of Christ. (2 Corin. 4).

Just like in giving offering, 2 Corinthians 8:12 says "Offering is accepted according to what one has, and not according to what he does not have;" we cannot convince God that we can harness the treasure outside and apply it well when we have not demonstrated that we can harness and apply the treasure that God has put within us.

This is why bible says in Ephesians 3:20 that God is able to do far more abundantly beyond all that we ask or think, according to the power that works within us.

#### **Conclusion:**

As we seek to harness and apply the "hidden treasures and riches stored in secret places" in the world, let's ensure that His power within us is at high momentum.

Let's harness and apply the Treasure in our jar of clay (God's WORD, God's GLORY, God's POWER and our TESTIMONIES).

The inner treasure links us to the outside ones through the Spirit of God who connects our spiritual eyes to see opportunities (hidden treasures and riches stored in secret places) in the world. "As far as you can see cannot be just by physical eyes".
