2024 Important Broad Promises Revealed

Psalm 23: 1-6

Cod is our shophard

God is our shepherd, He will position us and make our cup overflow. Exodus 19:4

God will carry us on eagles' wings, no matter what comes up.

Ecclesiastes 12:13

Our only role is to fear God, listen to the Holy Spirit, in us, and obey His command.

Exodus 19:4, God recounts how He has carried Israel on eagles' wings:

4 'You yourselves have seen what I did to Egypt, and how I carried you on eagles' wings and brought you to myself'.

VS 5-6

" ⁵ Now if you obey me fully and keep my covenant, then out of all nations you will be my treasured possession. Although the whole earth is mine, ⁶ you will be for Me a kingdom of priests and a holy nation."

Text: 2 Kings 6: 8-18

⁸ Now the king of Syria was making war against Israel; and he consulted with his servants, saying, "My camp will be in such and such a place." ⁹ And the man of God sent to the king of Israel, saying, "Beware that you do not pass this place, for the Syrians are coming down there." … ¹¹ Therefore the heart of the king of Syria was greatly troubled by this thing; and he called his servants and said to them, "Will you not show me which of us *is* for the king of Israel?" ¹² And one of his servants said, "None, my lord, O king; but Elisha, the prophet who *is* in Israel, tells the king of Israel the words that you speak in your bedroom. …" ¹⁴ Therefore he sent horses and chariots and a great army there, and they came by night and surrounded the city.

¹⁵ And when the servant of the man of God arose early and went out, there was an army, surrounding the city with horses and chariots. And his servant said to him, "Alas, my master! What shall we do?" ¹⁶ So he answered, "**Do not fear, for those who** *are* **with us** *are* **more than those who** *are* **with them.**" ¹⁷ And Elisha prayed, and said, "LORD, I pray, open his eyes that he may see." Then the LORD opened the eyes of the young man, and he saw. And behold, the mountain *was* full of horses and chariots of fire all around Elisha. ¹⁸ So when *the Syrians* came down to him, Elisha prayed to the LORD, and said, "Strike this people, I pray, with blindness." And He struck them with blindness according to the word of Elisha.

Brethren, enemy came against Elisha with horses and chariots & a great army BUT

God surrounded Elisha with horses and chariots carrying fire.

In Psalm 104:4, David said "God makes the winds His messengers, flames of fire His servants."

While Elisha understood what God does, his servant did not understand.

Because of Elisha's understanding, he was able to say to his servant, " "Do not fear, for those who are with us are more than those who are with them."

Elisha understood, that whatever weapon the enemy comes with against him, the Lord will respond with a similar but stronger weapon of fire.

Isaiah 59:18, says God will repay according to their deeds: fury to His enemies, retribution to His foes, and recompense to the islands."

Brethren, the fact is that the enemy comes against us with the weapon we fear the most. The enemy came against Elisha with the weapon Elisha feared the most; that

It is what gave him the highest panic.

In 2 Kings 2:11-12, "¹¹As they (Elijah and Elisha) were walking along and talking together, suddenly a chariot of fire with horses of fire appeared and separated the two of them, and Elijah went up into heaven in a whirlwind. ¹²As Elisha watched, he cried out, "My father, my father, the chariots and horsemen of Israel!" And he saw Elijah no more. So taking hold of his own clothes, he tore them in two.

Chariots and horsemen of Israel were revered as most powerful; and that caused Elisha to panic.

So, when the enemy was coming to him, it came in chariots and horses (though now not of Isreal).

Brethren, what is that weapon that the enemy uses to give you the highest panic? **God says don't fear!** Greater is He that is in you than he that is in them.

This weapon could even be a prayer point that the enemy is telling you "God will not answer it".

Please, tell the enemy that God will not only answer it, but He will answer it by fire. Isaiah 59:19 says that "when the enemy shall come in like a flood, the Spirit of the LORD shall lift up a standard against him."

Brethren, enemy tries to align weapon used against us with what we fear the most or our greatest concern for the moment or at least what he thinks it is.

Our job is to recognize the scheme of the enemy and take our stand.

I Samuel 17: ¹⁰ Then the Philistine said, "This day I defy the armies of Israel! Give me a man and let us fight each other." ¹¹ **On hearing the Philistine's words,** Saul and all the Israelites were dismayed and terrified.

Enemy presented same 'words' to David, but he recognized his scheme and took his stand.

This weapon could even be a prayer point that the enemy is telling you "God will not answer it".

Please, tell the enemy that God will not only answer it, but He will answer it by fire. Isaiah 59:19 says that "when the enemy shall come in like a flood, the Spirit of the LORD shall lift up a standard against him."

Brethren, God put fire into David's stone and killed Goliath.

David said (Psalm 104:4), "God makes flames of fire His servants."

Conclusion: "Do not fear! Greater is He that is with us than he that is in the world."

Bible says "Put on the whole armor of God so that you will understand enemy's schemes." The enemy will always present what we fear the most or worry about the most. **Let us resist him** and he will flee. If he doesn't flee, he will be consumed by the weapon of fire that God assigns to you against the enemy.
