eagles' wings, no
matter what comes up.**

Ecclesiastes 12:13

**Our only role is to fear
God, listen to the Holy
Spirit, in us, and obey
His command.**

Exodus 19:4, God recounts how He has carried Israel on eagles' wings:

4 'You yourselves have seen what I did to Egypt, and how I carried you on eagles' wings and brought you to myself.'

vs 5-6

'5 Now if you obey me fully and keep my covenant, then out of all nations you will be my treasured possession. Although the whole earth is mine, 6 you will be for Me a kingdom of priests and a holy nation.'

THERE IS POWER IN HIS GLORY.

Text 2 Chronicles 7: 1-3

¹ When Solomon finished praying, fire came down from heaven and consumed the burnt offering and the sacrifices, and the glory of the LORD filled the temple. ² The priests could not enter the temple of the LORD because the glory of the LORD filled it. ³ When all the Israelites saw the fire coming down and the glory of the LORD above the temple, they knelt on the pavement with their faces to the ground, and they worshiped and gave thanks to the LORD, saying,
“He is good; His love endures forever.”

Brethren, last week, we were reminded that **‘God Duplicates Himself in His Glory’**. And our text focused on: **Isaiah 58:8** “then your righteousness will go before you, and the glory of the LORD will be your rear guard.”

THERE IS POWER IN HIS GLORY.

“Without holiness (no one will see the Lord” (Hebrews 12:14)

We see in our text that Solomon used righteousness, offering, sacrifices and prayer to bring down the fire of God and the glory of God into the temple and all Israelites outside saw it, bow their faces to the ground, and worshiped and gave thanks to the LORD.

SOLOMON DID NOT TURN TO THE PEOPLE TO COMPEL THEM TO BELIEVE, HE FOCUSED ON BRINGING DOWN THE FIRE AND GLORY OF GOD. **BIBLE SAYS** “BY THEIR FRUIT, YOU SHALL KNOW THEM”

Our job is to focus on bringing down the fire and glory of God.

When we do that, everyone, every nation and every people will see it and bow their faces to the ground, worshiped and gave thanks to the LORD

This principle will enable us “extend God’s love to all the nations”. As we bring down the fire and glory of God in this place through our “righteousness, offering, sacrifices and prayer”, the fire & glory of God will come down and people in all nations will see it.

THERE IS POWER IN HIS GLORY.

Matthew 5:16 says “people may see your good deeds and glorify your Father in heaven.”

In Acts 16: 25-33, we see that Paul and Silas did not compel the jailer to be saved. The jailer saw the glory of God and sort to serve the Lord in heaven.

Paul and Silas were thrown into prison. ²⁵ About midnight Paul and Silas were praying and singing hymns to God, and the other prisoners were listening to them. ²⁶ Suddenly there was such a violent earthquake that the foundations of the prison were shaken. At once all the prison doors flew open, and everyone’s chains came loose.” Brethren, the glory of the Lord came down and broke off all the chains (all the problems) that were holding them bound. ²⁹ The jailer called for lights, rushed in and fell trembling before Paul and Silas. ³⁰ He then brought them out and asked, **“Sirs, what must I do to be saved?”** ³³ At that hour of the night the jailer took them and washed their wounds; then immediately he and all his household were baptized.”

Brethren, let us focus on bringing down the fire and glory of God and people and nations will be saved.

THERE IS POWER IN HIS GLORY.

Brethren, there is power in His glory. And God send His glory at any time and at His own will. But when His glory comes down something significant happens.

In our text even “² the priests could not enter the temple of the LORD because the glory of the LORD filled it.”

In Joshua 6:1-5, the gates of Jericho were securely barred because of the Israelites. No one went out and no one came in. (when things seem to be tightly locked off, ask God what should we do?). ² **Then the LORD said to Joshua**, “See, I have delivered Jericho into your hands, along with its king and its fighting men. ³ March around the city once with all the armed men. Do this for six days. ⁴ Have seven priests carry trumpets of rams’ horns in front of the ark. On the seventh day, march around the city seven times, with the priests blowing the trumpets. ⁵ When you hear them sound a long blast on the trumpets, have the whole army give a loud shout; then the wall of the city will collapse. ⁶ So Joshua (Joshua obeyed the Lord’s instructions)..... ²⁰.... when the men gave a loud shout, (the glory of God came down) the wall collapsed

THERE IS POWER IN HIS GLORY.

To bring down His glory,

1. We just need, first, to make sure that the path we are on is the one that God has mapped out for us.
2. Then secondly, we put our righteousness forward and stay expectant.

- Solomon stayed expectant by using righteousness, offering, sacrifices and prayer.
- Paul and Silas stayed expectant by using Righteousness and Praises & hymns
- Joshua stayed expectant through Righteousness and Action rooted on obeying God's instruction to march round the wall as God had instructed.

As we put our righteousness forward and stay expectant using defined approach, God's glory will come down. And when His glory comes down, the power in His glory will break every chains.
