Part 22: Put your hand on the plow and move forward

Text: Luke 9:62 “⁶² Jesus replied, “No one who puts a hand to the plow and looks back is fit for service in the kingdom of God.”

Genesis 26:12 “Isaac planted crops in that land and the same year reaped a hundredfold, because the LORD blessed him.”

Life Application:

- **Tenacity** is the quality of holding fast to a goal, persisting without quitting, and refusing to give up despite obstacles.
- **Tenacity** is the active drive to push forward and refuse to quit. **Resilience** is the passive capacity to bounce back after a setback. Tenacity focuses on sustained effort toward a goal, while resilience focuses on recovery and adaptation after trauma or failure

Core Differences

Tenacity (The Push):

Sticking to a task.

Refusing to let go.

Pushing through hard work and Driven by a goal.

Resilience (The Bounce):

Recovering from shock.

Adapting to change.

Healing after loss, Absorbing stress

Text: Luke 9:62, Jesus replied:

“No one who puts a hand to the plow and looks back is fit for service in the kingdom of God.”
Luke 9 presents various scenarios that should help us understand HOW we should **“Put your hand on the plow and move forward”**

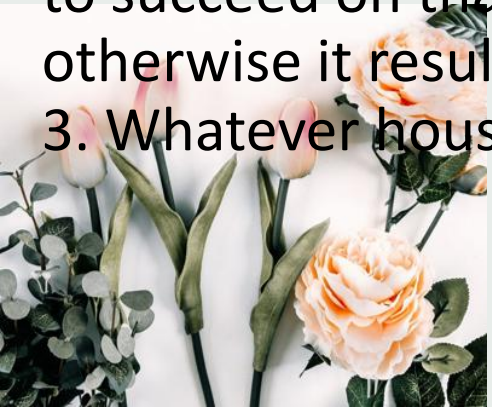
vs 1-7 “Jesus Sends Out the Twelve

“¹When Jesus had called the Twelve together, he gave them power and authority to drive out all demons and to cure diseases, ²and he sent them out to proclaim the kingdom of God and to heal the sick. ³He told them: “Take nothing for the journey—no staff, no bag, no bread, no money, no extra shirt. ⁴Whatever house you enter, stay there until you leave that town.”

This text has several lessons to us: for example,

1. As Christian, be on pathways/endeavour that the Lord has defined for you.
2. Once the Lord has given you a pathway, He positions the resources and equipping you need to succeed on that pathway, meaning you should not change pathways without His approval otherwise it results to you fending for yourself, which becomes difficult.
3. Whatever house you enter, stay there until you leave that town, thus demonstrating enough reasons for resources to be arranged for you.

Romans 8: ²⁸ And we know that in all things God works for the good of those who love Him, who have been called according to his purpose.



Part 22: Put your hand on the plow and move forward

Vs 10-17 Jesus Feeds the Five Thousand

¹⁰ When the apostles returned, they reported to Jesus what they had done. Then he took them with him and they withdrew by themselves to a town called Bethsaida, ¹¹ but the crowds learned about it and followed him. He welcomed them and spoke to them about the kingdom of God and healed those who needed healing. ¹² Late in the afternoon the Twelve came to him and said, “Send the crowd away so they can go to the surrounding villages and countryside and find food and lodging, because we are in a remote place here.”

¹³ **He replied, “You give them something to eat.”** (Demonstrating that He has positioned the resources to do this)

They answered, “We have only five loaves of bread and two fish—unless we go and buy food for all this crowd.” ¹⁴ (About five thousand men were there.). **But He said** to his disciples, “Have them sit down in groups of about fifty each... ¹⁶ Taking the five loaves and the two fish and looking up to heaven, He gave thanks and broke them. ¹⁷ They all ate and were satisfied, and the disciples picked up twelve basketfuls of broken pieces that were left over.

Lessons

4. For whatever endeavor God called you, He has provided the tools/equipping. Just prayerfully look out for them
5. Be prayerful – He looked up. (Bible says it is better to pray continually (1 Thessalonians 5:17). ... Ask God to reveal the tools for the work.

Vs 18-20 (Matthew 16:16-20) Peter Declares That Jesus Is the Messiah

¹⁸ Once when Jesus was praying in private and his disciples were with him, he asked them, “Who do the crowds say I am?”

¹⁹ They replied, “Some say John the Baptist; others say Elijah; and still others, that one of the prophets of long ago has come back to life.” ²⁰ “But what about you?” he asked. “Who do you say I am?”

Matt 16: ¹⁶ Simon Peter answered, “You are the Messiah, the Son of the living God.”

¹⁷ Jesus replied, “Blessed are you, Simon son of Jonah, for this was not revealed to you by flesh and blood, but by my Father in heaven. ¹⁸ **And I tell you that you are Peter**, and on this rock I will build my church, and the gates of Hades will not overcome it.” ¹⁹ I will give you the keys of the kingdom of heaven; whatever you bind on earth will be^[d] bound in heaven, and whatever you loose on earth will be^[e] loosed in heaven.” **Lessons:**

6. Be intentional about your work with God. He evaluates for you: “Who do you say I am?”

7. Jesus always recognises and rewards that child with the right response... **“And I tell you that**

you are Peter, and on this rock I will build my church”

James 4:8 “⁸ Draw near to God and He will draw near to you. ”

Conclusion

- Be intentional about your Christianity engagement and relationship with God
- Be tenacious on that pathway, praying continuously

- In **Exodus 17:6** : Moses and Israelites did not reliable that water was in the rock along their pathway, when Moses asked God, He told him to strike the rock and water came
- In **Genesis 26:1-16** “there was a famine in the land ²The LORD appeared to Isaac and said, “Do not go down to Egypt; live in the land where I tell you to live. ³**Stay in this land for a while**, and I will be with you and will bless you. ¹² Isaac planted crops in that land and the same year reaped a hundredfold, because the LORD blessed him. ¹³ The man became rich, and his wealth continued to grow until he became very wealthy. ¹⁴ He had so many flocks and herds and servants that the Philistines envied him.
