THE WORD OF GOD May 26 2019

"SIT AT MY RIGHT HAND UNTIL I PUT YOUR ENEMIES UNDER YOUR FEET"

TEXT:

Matthew 22:44 "Sit at my right hand until I put your enemies under your feet."

Acts 2:34-35: "Sit at my right hand ³⁵ until I make your enemies a footstool for your feet."

This was revealed to David (Psalm 110:1). David said "The LORD says to my lord" "Sit at My right hand until I make Your enemies a footstool for Your feet."

God revealed that though Jesus and those who believe in Him would have many enemies, Jesus will defeat His enemies and wash away the sins of men on earth so that while He sits at the right hand of God, He will help those who believe to defeat the enemies they face on earth.

Hebrews 1:3 "³ The Son radiates God's own glory and expresses the very character of God, and he sustains everything by the mighty power of his command. When he had cleansed us from our sins, he sat down in the place of honor at the right hand of the majestic God in heaven."

God had always intervened on behalf of His people but after Jesus paid the price for sin, it became automatic guarantee that the saved will enjoy that privilege.

Ephesians 2:10

For we are God's workmanship, created in Christ Jesus to do good works, which God prepared in advance as our way of life.

Brethren,

God is interested in putting our enemies under your feet.

In every situation, we must quickly replace fear with faith.

We are seated with Jesus in heavenly places far above all principalities and powers. This was the specific request Jesus made to His Father for us.

Though the enemy comes with his schemes, God will give us the revelation as to how to deal with the devil.
