THE GOD THAT MOVES MOUNTAINS. JESUS CHRIST IS THE SAME YESTERDAY, AND TODAY AND FOREVER.

VICTORY IS YOURS TO TAKE: "IT IS FINISHED."

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ANCHOR BIBLE REFERENCES

Hebrews 13: 5-8

5 God has said,

"Never will I leave you; never will I forsake you."

So we say with confidence,

"The Lord is my helper; I will not be afraid.

What can mortal man do to me?"

- ⁷ Remember your leaders, who spoke the word of God to you. Consider the outcome of their way of life and imitate their faith.
- ⁸ Jesus Christ is the same yesterday and today and forever.

Luke 5:37-38

"No one pours new wine into old wineskins. If he does, the new wine will burst the skins, the wine will spill, and the wineskins will be ruined."

"Instead, new wine is poured into new wineskins."

(This year, we must have a fresh vision of our Christian life)

As we consider the life of the leaders and their faith, let us apply the lessons and, thus, create new wineskins and expand our spiritual container to enable God to move the mountains He has planned to move for us from 2023.

Our Mandate Remains:

- "The House of Prayer for all Nations; Extending God's Love to all the Nations."
- We are sowers (not eaters) but sowers reap in multiple folds.
- 2 Chronicles 7:13-14 "When I shut up heaven and there is no rain, or command the locusts to devour the land, or send pestilence among My people, if My people who are called by My name will humble themselves, and pray and seek My face, and turn from their wicked ways, then I will hear from heaven, and will forgive their sin and heal their land."
- Ezekiel 22:30 "³⁰ And I sought for a man among them, that should make up the hedge (wall), and stand in the gap before me for the land, that I should not destroy it: but I found none."

John 19:30 Jesus said, "It is finished." This statement by Jesus has a significant implication when we talk about mountains and we taking our victory.

It is finished means the work is completed. And that the work was completed by Jesus Chris.

In John 17, as Jesus was about to go to the cross, He prayed, "Father, the hour has come. Glorify your Son, that your Son may glorify you. ² For you granted Him authority over all people that He might give eternal life to all <u>those you have given Him</u>. ³ Now this is eternal life: that they know you, the only true God, and Jesus Christ, whom you have sent. "

Romans 5:8 "While we were still sinners, Christ died for us." **In Luke 19:10**, Jesus said 'the Son of Man came to seek and to save the lost."

1 Peter 3:18 says that ¹⁸ Christ suffered once for sins, the righteous for the unrighteous, that He might bring us to God."

Romans 6:23 "for the wages of sin is death, but the gift of God is eternal life in Christ Jesus our Lord."

Romans 4:25 "Jesus was delivered up for our trespasses and raised for our justification."

Colossians 1:22 "he has now reconciled in his body of flesh by his death, in order to present you holy and blameless and above reproach before him."

Hebrews 9:28 "so Christ, having been offered once to bear the sins of many, will appear a second time, not to deal with sin but to save those who are eagerly waiting for him."

Brethren, before His death on the cross, everyone was far from God and everyone had to bear the punishment for his or her sins:

- Inherited sin (e.g. ancestral sin)
- imputed sin (credited from Adam and Eve) cl
- Personal sin

By reason of the cross, Ephesians 2:3 says

"You who once were far away have been brought near through the blood of Christ"

His death and resurrection created a pathway that enables us to walk from the side of sin (darkness to side of righteousness (light).

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"IT IS FINISHED."

Colossians 1:12-14

12 giving thanks to the Father, who <u>has qualified you to share in the</u> inheritance of the saints in the light. 13He has rescued us from the dominion of darkness and brought us into the kingdom of His beloved Son, 14in whom we have redemption, the forgiveness of sins.

His dead has "qualified us to share in the inheritance of the saints in the light." To access this qualification requires one-on-one decision.

Acts 3:19 "¹⁹ Repent, then, and turn to God, so that your sins may be wiped out, that times of refreshing may come from the Lord."

Repent, then convert (change) your kingdom, and your sins are then blotted away and we then come to the time of refreshing where we enjoy "it is finished".

In the kingdom of light,

Isaiah 60:20 says "Your sun shall no longer go down, Nor shall your moon withdraw itself; For the LORD will be your everlasting light, And the days of your mourning shall be ended.

Proverbs 10:22 "The blessing of the LORD makes one rich, And He adds no sorrow with it."

There is no mountain in the kingdom of light that ca harm us. What we should be concerned about, "WHAT SIDE ARE WE AT ANY POINT IN TIME"?

Once in the kingdom of light,

#1. Philippians 2:12 (NV) "continue to work out your salvation with fear and trembling"

1 Corinthians 10:12 ", if you think you are standing firm, be careful that you don't fall!

#2. If you repent, you MUST Convert. Repentance is turning away from sin. The work of repented is being carried out by trinity:

John 6;44a Father convince, the Son connects us to God and the Holy Spirit convicts us. Holy Spirit's conviction is by giving you a personal understanding of yourself and what you have done he communicates it clearly. John 16:13 says "He leads you unto all truths."

If you repent, you MUST Convert from darkness domain to kingdom of light. If you repent and don't convert, you go back to your sins e.g. Judas did not convert, so committed suicide.

#3. Be careful not to loose your spot in the kingdom of light
Revelations 3:16 "So, because you are lukewarm (not converting)—
neither hot nor cold—I am about to spit you out of my mouth."
Matthew 24: ¹² Because of the increase of wickedness, the love of most will grow cold, ¹³ but the one who stands firm to the end will be

saved. ¹⁴ And this gospel (principle) of the kingdom will be preached in the whole world as a testimony to all nations, and then the end will come.

#4. No evil will befall you. No hand that forms against you will prosper. No mountain can defeat you.

Psalm 46: 10 He says, "Be still, and know that I am God; I will be exalted among the nations, I will be exalted in the earth."

Brethren,

"IT IS FINISHED."

John 1:12-13 "as many as received him, to them gave he power to become the sons of God, even to them that believe on his name:

Every mountain on the kingdom of light has the glory of God. It can never consume us. The job of the mountain is to bring us t the expected end.
