Ezekiel 28:13-14

¹³“You were in Eden, the garden of God. Your clothing was adorned with every precious stone — all beautifully crafted for you and set in the finest gold. They were given to you on the day you were created. ¹⁴ I ordained and anointed you as the mighty angelic guardian. You had access to the holy mountain of God and walked among the stones of fire.”

Walking among the stones of fire (walking in Christ’s triumphal procession) keeps our intimate relationship with God and gives us access to His glory. We become guiding light to others, as shown through our words, action and behaviour.

2 Corinthians 2:14-15 “¹⁴ Thanks be to God, who always leads us as captives in Christ’s triumphal procession and uses us to spread the aroma of the knowledge of Him everywhere. ¹⁵ For we are to God the pleasing aroma of Christ among those who are being saved and those who are perishing.”

Text: 2 Corinthians 10:4

“The weapons of our warfare *are* not carnal but mighty in God for pulling down strongholds”.

“The weapons of our warfare are not worldly but are powerful through God for the demolition of strongholds”.

Antecedent: Mark 12: 30-31

“³⁰ Love the Lord your God with all your heart and with all your soul and with all your mind and with all your strength. ³¹ The second is this: ‘Love your neighbor as yourself.’ There is no commandment greater than these.”

John 17: Jesus prayed for disciples “¹⁶ They are not of the world, even as I am not of it. ...¹⁸ As you sent me into the world, I have sent them into the world.”

If we are not of the world, our weapon of warfare **CANNOT** be of the world.



Series Part 10: Use the Weapon of Your Warfare

How did Jesus use His weapon

1. He made God His ALL

John 5:19 “So, Jesus said to them, “Truly, truly, I say to you, the Son can do nothing of His own accord, but only what he sees the Father doing. For whatever the Father does, that the Son does likewise”.

2. He made out time for prayer to nurture/polish His relationship with God

Hebrews 5:7 “During the days of Jesus’ earthly life, He offered up prayers and petitions with loud cries and tears to the One who could save Him from death, and He was heard because of His reverence”.

Mark 1:35 “Very early in the morning, while it was still dark, Jesus got up, left the house and went off to a solitary place, where he prayed.”

1 Thessalonians 5:17 “Pray without ceasing”.

3. He exercised His power

Mark 11:12-25 “Jesus was hungry. ¹³ Seeing in the distance a fig tree in leaf, he went to find out if it had any fruit. When he reached it, he found nothing but leaves, because it was not the season for figs. ¹⁴ Then he said to the tree, “May no one ever eat fruit from you again.”

Brethren, “it was not the season for figs”. Yet Jesus expected figs.

In God’s kingdom principle, fruits can come anytime that God chooses.

1 Corinthians 16:13 *“Be on your guard; stand firm in the faith; be courageous; be strong”*

2 Timothy 4:2, Paul said to him: “Preach the word; be prepared in season and out of season...”

➤ **Let’s Exercise your power**

Eph 6:12 “For our struggle (fight) is not against flesh and blood, but against the rulers, against the authorities, against the powers of this dark world and against the spiritual forces of evil in the heavenly realms”. **BUT WE HAVE THE POWER FROM GOD**

Hebrews 4:12 “For the word of God is alive and powerful. It is sharper than the sharpest two-edged sword, cutting between soul and spirit, between joint and marrow. It exposes our innermost thoughts and desires”. Brethren, **SPEAK THE WORD TO THE SITUATION**

Jeremiah 51:20 “See, I have appointed you today over nations and kingdoms to uproot and tear down, to destroy and overthrow, to build and plant.”

Jeremiah 51:20 ““You are My battle-ax and weapons of war...”

Jeremiah 17:7 “blessed is the one who trusts in the LORD, whose confidence is in Him.,,, It does not fear when heat comes; ... It has no worries in a year of drought **and never fails to bear fruit.**”

John 15:8 , Jesus said “This is to My Father’s glory, that you bear much fruit,”
