Ezekiel 28:13-14

"You were in Eden, the garden of God. Your clothing was adorned with every precious stone — red carnelian, pale-green peridot, white moonstone, blue-green beryl, onyx, green jasper, blue lapis lazuli, turquoise, and emerald—

all beautifully crafted for you and set in the finest gold. They were given to you on the day you were created. ¹⁴I ordained and anointed you as the mighty angelic guardian.

You had access to the holy mountain of God and

walked among the stones of fire."

Walking among the stones of fire keeps our intimate relationship with God and access to His glory. The holy mountain of God has God's presence. As 2 Corinthians 2:14 says it, "We are in Christ's triumphal procession."

Texts:

Deuteronomy 29:29

"The secret things belong to the LORD our God, but the things revealed belong to us and to our children forever."

Amos 3:7 ""Surely the Lord GOD does nothing without revealing His plan to His servants the prophets."

Matthew 11:25

"Jesus declared, "I praise You, Father, Lord of heaven and earth, because You have hidden these things from the wise & learned and revealed them to little children."

Psalm 25:14

"The LORD confides in those who fear increasing reveals His covenant to them."

John 16:13 "When the Spirit of truth comes, He will guide you into all truth."

Revelations are in levels, "God will move us from glory to glory" from one level unto another,, "according to the Holy Spirit power that is at work within us." (Eph 3:20)

Getting revelation is not by age, how long as Christians, wisdom or how learned BUT by how the Holy Spirit is at work within us. Trick is increasing daily activities with the Holy Spirit.

✓ There is a BIG Difference between the actions of people who get revelations and those of them who don't.

Jesus worked and walked through revelations:

"Destroy this temple and I will rebuild it in 3-days" (John 2:19) - a revelation about His resurrection.

The Jews replied, "This temple took forty-six years to build," "and You are going to raise it up in three days?" (John 2:20)

Hebrews 12:2 "Because of the joy awaiting Him, he endured the cross, disregarding its shame. Now he is seated in the place of honor beside God's throne."

John 18: ⁴ Jesus, knowing all that was going to happen to Him, went out and asked them (soldiers and some officials from the chief priests and the Pharisees), "Who is it you want?", ⁵ "Jesus of Nazareth," they replied. "I am he," Jesus said ⁶ When Jesus said, "I am he," they drew back and fell to the ground.

⁷ Again he asked them, "Who is it you want?" "Jesus of Nazareth," they said. ⁸ Jesus answered, "I told you that I am he."...¹⁰Then Simon Peter, who had a sword, drew it

and struck the high priest's servant, cutting off his right ear. ¹¹ Jesus commanded Peter, "Put your sword away! Shall I not drink the cup the Father has given me?"

Jesus was getting revelations at this point, but Peter was not. So, their actions were different. However, it is the action based on revelation that is correct.

✓ God will give you revelations on things concerning you and your family but not necessarily thing concerning others.

The same Peter got a different kind of revelation:

In Matthew 16, 15 "But what about you?" Jesus asked. "Who do you say I am?"

¹⁶ Simon Peter answered, "You are the Messiah, the Son of the living God."

¹⁷ Jesus replied, "Blessed are you, rock, son of Jonah, for this was not revealed to you by flesh and blood, but by my Father in heaven.

✓ Once we are getting revelation, God has confidence in us & uses us for His purpose Matthew 16:18 Jesus said ¹⁸ And I tell you that you are Peter and on this rock I will build my church, and the gates of hell will not overcome it.

Brethren, last week, we discussed the virtual private network (VPN) of the believer. In Matthew 16:18, Jesus tells Peter, He will give his church a VPN so that the gates of hell (the

prince of the Persian kingdom will not prevail against it.

Brethren we get VPN over us and our activities when we are in Christ's triumphal procession, walking among the stones of fire.

Devil sees our VPN and flees

In Job 1: 8-10, 8 the LORD said to Satan, "Have you considered my servant Job? There is no one on earth like him; he is blameless and upright, a man who fears God and shuns evil."

⁹ "Does Job fear God for nothing?" Satan replied. ¹⁰ "Have you not put a hedge around him and his household and everything he has?

Brethren, that hedge is God's shelter, it is Job's VPN,

Psalm 91:1 says "Whoever dwells in the shelter of the Most High will rest in the shadow of the Almighty.

Conclusion

We get revelations when we are in Christ's procession, walking among the stones of fire. God uses us for His purpose and envelops in in shelter/hedge/VPN where devil cannot penetrate.
