WALKING AMONG THE STONES OF FIRE

Ezekiel 28:13-14

¹³"You were in Eden, the garden of God. Your clothing was adorned with every precious stone — all beautifully crafted for you and set in the finest gold. They were given to you on the day you were created. ¹⁴ I ordained and anointed you as the mighty angelic guardian. You had access to the holy mountain of God and walked among the stones of fire."

Walking among the stones of fire (walking in Christ's triumphal procession) keeps our intimate relationship with God and gives us access to His glory. We become guiding light to others, as shown through our words, action and behaviour.

2 Corinthians 2:14-15 "¹⁴ Thanks be to God, who always leads us as captives in Christ's triumphal procession and uses us to spread the aroma of the knowledge of Him everywhere. ¹⁵ For we are to God the pleasing aroma of Christ among those who are being saved and those who are perishing."

Series Part 27: WORSHIP GOD IN THE BEAUTY OF HIS HOLINESS

TEXT: Psalm 29:2

"Give unto the LORD the glory due to His name; Worship the LORD in the beauty of His holiness."

Brethren, we **are** on Eagles' wings, walking among the stones of fire and in Christ's triumphal procession.

Have we ever wondered how others who had traveled the same path did it?

- How did they give to God the glory due to Him?
- How did they worship God in the beauty of His holiness?
- What lessons can we learn from them?
- Which of the lessons can I/You personally adopt and implement?

Example: Abraham (Genesis 12 and 13)

Similar to God carrying us on Eagle's Wings, the LORD had said to Abram, "Go from your country, your people and your father's household to the land I will show you." (Gen 12:1)

⁴ So Abram went, as the LORD had told him.

[As he travelled, he built alters of worship and worshipped God in the beauty of His holiness.]

⁶ Abram traveled through the land as far as the site of the great tree of Moreh at Shechem. At that time the Canaanites were in the land. ⁷ The LORD appeared to Abram and said, "To your offspring I will give this land." So, he built an **altar (of worship)** there to the LORD, who had appeared to him.

⁸ From there he went on toward the hills east of Bethel and pitched his tent, with Bethel on the west and Ai on the east. There he built an **altar (of worship)** to the LORD and called on the name of the LORD.

¹⁰ Now there was a famine in the land, and Abram went down to Egypt to live there for a while because the famine was severe. [God was with Abrahm in Egypt].

¹⁶ ... Abram acquired sheep and cattle, male and female donkeys, male and female servants, and camels.

Series Part 27: WORSHIP GOD IN THE BEAUTY OF HIS HOLINESS

Gen 13: ¹So Abram went up from Egypt to the Negev, with his wife and everything he had, and Lot went with him. ² Abram had become very wealthy in livestock and in silver and gold.

³ From the Negev he went from place to place until he came to Bethel, to the place between Bethel and Ai where his tent had been earlier ⁴ and where he had first built an altar. There Abram called on the name of the LORD.

[Abraham recognized that he was on God's leadership every step of the way. He set out time to worship God for that purpose].

¹⁴ The LORD said to Abram after Lot had parted from him, "Look around from where you are, to the north and south, to the east and west. ¹⁵ All the land that you see I will give to you and your offspring^[a] forever. ¹⁶ I will make your offspring like the dust of the earth, so that if anyone could count the dust, then your offspring could be counted. ¹⁷ Go, walk through the length and breadth of the land, for I am giving it to you." ¹⁸ So Abram went to live near the great trees of Mamre at Hebron, where he pitched his tents. There he built **an altar (of worship)** to the LORD.

Series Part 27: WORSHIP GOD IN THE BEAUTY OF HIS HOLINESS Conclusion

Based on God's call on Abraham, we have seen:

- How he gave to God the glory due to Him by recognizing that God's power was wherever he was standing: whether in plenty of in famine that led him to Egypt. Of course, when he got there, God blessed him with plenty. It is ok for us to seek food elsewhere when the is famine where we are but recognize that God is with you.
- How he worshipped God in the beauty of His holiness by building alters of worship along the way
- What lessons can we learn from Abraham: God's word will surely come to pass if we don't waver. Famine may come on the path God is taking us and it is ok to seek food from elsewhere but return to the path. Abraham returned to where he had built his first alter (Gen 13:3-4).
- Which of the lessons can I/You personally adopt and implement? Although this is personal, today, we are reminded to worship God in the beauty of His holiness. It is important for us to always recognize God's presence, consistently build alter and worship God along the way.
