## WALKING AMONG THE STONES OF FIRE

### **Ezekiel 28:13-14**

<sup>13</sup>"You were in Eden, the garden of God. Your clothing was adorned with every precious stone — all beautifully crafted for you and set in the finest gold. They were given to you on the day you were created. <sup>14</sup> I ordained and anointed you as the mighty angelic guardian. You had access to the holy mountain of God and walked among the stones of fire."

Walking among the stones of fire (walking in Christ's triumphal procession) keeps our intimate relationship with God and gives us access to His glory. We become guiding light to others, as shown through our words, action and behaviour.

**2 Corinthians 2:14-15** "<sup>14</sup> Thanks be to God, who always leads us as captives in Christ's triumphal procession and uses us to spread the aroma of the knowledge of Him everywhere. <sup>15</sup> For we are to God the pleasing aroma of Christ among those who are being saved and those who are perishing."

#### Series Part 12: YOU ARE THE AROMA OF CHRIST

**Text: 2 Corinthians 2:15** 

<sup>15</sup> We are to God the pleasing aroma of Christ among those who are being saved and those who are perishing."

**Aroma -** a distinctive, typically pleasant smell.

Last week, we were reminded of the need to 'leverage and practice discernment power.'

The overall outcome of our gift of discernment is "greater spiritual growth and alignment with God's will"

Today we are reminded that 'we are to God the pleasing aroma of Christ'.

This is a call for us to align with God's will for our creation.

God knew, even at the time of creation, that man will fall and that Christ will go to the world and redeem man. He also knew that Christ's work will be for a short while and after that men will be raised up who will continue the work, doing it in Christ likeness manner ..... as in the aroma of Christ.

#### Therefore...

Gen 1: <sup>26</sup> God said, "Let us make mankind in our image, in our likeness, People who will take over from Christ must be like Him ...... carry His aroma

Jesus confirmed that He is here for a little while...

John 16:

<sup>15</sup>Everything that belongs to the Father is Mine. That is why I said that the Spirit will take from what is Mine and disclose it to you. <sup>16</sup>In a little while you will see Me no more, and then after a little while you will see Me." **17**Then some of His disciples asked one another, "Why is He telling us, 'In a little while you will not see Me, and then after a little while you will see Me' and 'Because I am going to the Father'?"

God knew that Jesus will be in the world for a little while, so He created man who will work like Jesus, carrying Jesus' aroma.... We are to God the pleasing aroma of Christ. When He looks at us, He sees Jesus in us.

As soon as Jesus started His ministry, He began His recruitment role, picking men who will take over from Him.

**Matthew 4:19, Jesus said to** Peter and his brother Andrew, "<sup>19</sup> "Come, follow me," "and I will send you out to fish for people." <sup>20</sup> At once they left their nets and followed him.

But as an aroma, what do you do? ....We must take over.

Matth 4: 12-17, Jesus took over from John the Baptist.

<sup>17</sup> From that time on Jesus began to preach, "Repent, for the kingdom of heaven has come near."

According to our text (**2 Corinthians 2:15**), <sup>15</sup> We are to God the pleasing aroma of Christ among those who are being saved and those who are perishing."

Therefore, we must be encouraging the saved to continue the race and be preaching to the unsaved .... ""Repent, for the kingdom of heaven has come near."

**John 6:38**, Jesus said to disciples "I have come down from heaven, not to do My own will, but to do the will of <u>Him who sent Me</u>."..... as God sent Him, God sends us.

Matthew 20:28 "Just as the Son of Man did not come to be served, but to serve."

**Philippians 2:8** And being found in appearance as a man, He humbled Himself Brethren, "we are ambassadors for Christ" **(2 Corinthians 5:20)**, let us spread His aroma to both the saved and unsaved.
