Text: Genesis 12: 2

""I will bless you...and you will be a blessing to others"

1 Peter 3: 8-9 but be a blessing, knowing that you were called to this, that you may inherit a blessing.

Jesus Inherited a blessing shown in Psalm 110:1 "Sit at My right hand until I make Your enemies a footstool for Your feet."

Brethren, when we watch a dancer, we learn the dance steps.

We are in Christ's triumphal procession, we learn how He dances. We learn to live with the mindset of Jesus. In this case, "How He blesses Others".

#5 BE A BLESSING TO OTHERS WITH A POSITIVE ATTITUDE

Positive attitude is: Contagious! for Inspiration not Reciprocity! Two-tiered: Me & Them!

Psalm 118:24 This is the day that the Lord has made; let us rejoice and be glad in it.

Philippians 4:8 Whatever is true, whatever is just, whatever is pure, whatever is lovely, whatever is commendable, excellence, worthy of praise, think about these things.

Psalm 24: Who may ascend the mountain of the LORD, Who may stand in his holy place? ⁴ The one who has clean hands and a pure heart.

Matt 7:9-10 "Which of you, if your son asks for bread, will give him a stone? ¹⁰ Or for a fish, give him a snake? 11 If you, know how to give good gifts to your children, how much more will your Father in heaven give good gifts to those who ask Him!

Jeremiah 29:11 "For I know the plans I have for you," declares the LORD, "plans to prosper you and not to harm you, plans to give you hope and a future.

Eph 6:10 be strong in the Lord and in the power of His might.

Romans 5:5 Hope does not put us to shame, because God's love has been poured out into our hearts through the Holy Spirit, who has been given to us. **Romans 8:28** We know that in all things God works for the good of those who love Him, who have been called according to His purpose.

Jesus built up Himself with positive attitude and then gave it to others! Positive Attitude is two-tiered: Me and then Others!

1. Jesus influenced people's attitude by demonstration of His own positive attitude, though which people saw whom He is & what is possible and then built their own. For example,

John 2:3-7, ³ When the wine was gone, Jesus' mother said to him, "They have no more wine." Jesus' initial response was "⁴ "Woman, why do you involve me?" Jesus replied. "My hour has not yet come.".... ⁷ Jesus said to the servants, "Fill the jars with water";..... And He gave them wine.

¹¹ What Jesus did here in Cana of Galilee was the first of the signs through which he revealed his glory; and his disciples believed in him.

Lessons: a. Through our positive attitude, we reveal what is possible to people and it will inspire them to develop a positive attitude.

- b. Jesus gave of what He had
- 2 Corinthians 8:12 "If a man is ready and willing to give (positive attitude), he should give of what he has, not of what he does not have".
- ... Unless you have positive attitude, you cannot give it.

- 2. Jesus healed a man's son who was sick at a distance, demonstrating his power and control over disease.
- 3. Jesus healed a man who had been disabled for 38 years, showing his ability to restore the disabled.
- 4. Jesus miraculously fed a large crowd with a few loaves of bread and fish, demonstrating his power to provide.
- 5. Jesus walked on the sea, showing his divine authority and power over nature.
- 6. Jesus raised Lazarus from the dead, showcasing his power over death.

Conclusion: Jesus consistently gave what He had.

To give positive attitude, it is ME first, then OTHERS.

Matthew 22:38 & 39: "You shall love the Lord your God with all your heart, with all your soul, with all your mind, and love your neighbor" "as yourself."

Ephesians 5:2 says we are "a fragrant aroma". The fragrance of positive attitude is on you, but people coming around you are refreshed by it and people who embrace you walk joyfully away with that smell.
