1 Peter 3: 8-9 but be a blessing, knowing that you were called to this, that you may inherit a blessing.

Jesus Inherited a blessing shown in Psalm 110:1 “Sit at My right hand until I make Your enemies a footstool for Your feet.”

Brethren, when we watch a dancer, we learn the dance steps.

We are in Christ's triumphal procession, we learn how He does it. **We learn to live with the mindset of Jesus.** In this case, "How He blesses Others".

#1 SERVE GOD WITH GRATITUDE AND THANKSGIVING

1 Thessalonians 5:18: "Give thanks in all circumstances; for this is God's will for you in Christ Jesus."

Jesus gave thanks in all circumstances

Circumstance A: Luke 10:21 - He gave thanks for two opposite things (Those who received and those who did not receive Him)

"Jesus rejoiced in the Holy Spirit and said, "I thank you, Father, Lord of heaven and earth, because you have hidden these things from the wise and the intelligent and have revealed them to infants; yes, Father, for such was your gracious will."

It's easy to be grateful to God when things work out. But we struggle with gratitude when they don't. Let us change to the mindset of Jesus. Thank God even when people didn't believe the gospel you just shared with them.

Circumstance B: Jesus gave thanks before feeding the 5000 – impossibilities happen!

Matthew 15:36; Mark 8:6; John 6:11:

In the presence of very little food (can be very little resource, very little capacity or capability, very little skill), He was not fretting or worrying over how little food there was for such a big crowd. But focused on Matthew 6:33” “seek first His kingdom and His righteousness, and all these things will be provided for you”.

In contrast, we saw Moses worry over his skills, eloquence, pharaoh's significance. "Who am I that I should go to Pharaoh, and that I should bring the children of Israel out of Egypt?" (Exodus 3:11). God told him "I will be with you".

Circumstance C: Jesus thanks God before presenting His prayers

John 11:41, 42 “⁴¹...Then Jesus looked up and said, “Father, I thank you that you have heard me. ⁴²I knew that you always hear me, but I said this for the benefit of the people standing here, that they may believe that you sent me.” ⁴³ When he had said this, Jesus called in a loud voice, “Lazarus, come out!”

Circumstance D: Jesus gave thanks at the Last Supper

Everyone has a cross, but the grace of God will be there. Thank God for your cross. Through His cross Jesus inherited blessings (... Sit ...until I make your enemies your footstool – Ps 110:1)

Conclusion: Be a blessing to others by demonstrating Gratitude and Thanksgiving.
