Text: Genesis 12: 2

""I will bless you...and you will be a blessing to others"

1 Peter 3: 8-9 but be a blessing, knowing that you were called to this, that you may inherit a blessing.

Jesus Inherited a blessing shown in Psalm 110:1 "Sit at My right hand until I make Your enemies a footstool for Your feet."

- 1. Serve God with Gratitude and Thanksgiving (Part 1)
- 2. Be a Blessing with Our Time and Resources (Part 2)

Brethren, when we watch a dancer, we learn the dance steps.

We are in Christ's triumphal procession, we learn how He does it. We learn to live with the mindset of Jesus. In this case, "How He blesses Others".

#2 BE A BLESSING WITH OUR TIME AND RESOURCES

"Freely you received, freely give" Matthew 10:6-8

Jesus was a blessing with His time and resources, demonstrating a commitment to serving others and using His gifts for the good of humanity. He prioritized spending time with people, particularly those marginalized or hurting. Additionally, He actively used His resources, both material and spiritual, to help those in need.

Spend time with the needy, give them your material resources and spiritual resources. From God Himself, we learn that giving quality time and resources to others is critical. Gensis 1:25-26 ²⁵...... And God saw that what He created was good. ²⁶ Then God said, "Let us make mankind in our image, in our likeness, so that they may rule over the fish in the sea and the birds in the sky, over the livestock and all the wild animals, and over all the creatures that move along the ground." ²⁷ So God created mankind in His own image. .. ²⁸ God blessed them and said to them, "Be fruitful and increase in number; fill

the earth and subdue it.

Brethren, all the output of God's time/labour, He willingly handed over to man in full.

God handed the baton over to Jesus, and Jesus continued on that trajectory. .

Matthew 28:18 ""All authority in heaven and on earth has been given to me".

John 5:20 "The Father loves the Son and shows Him all He does".

Acts 10:38 says, "How God anointed Jesus of Nazareth with the Holy Ghost and with power: who went about 'doing good' and healing all that were oppressed of the devil; for God was with him."

'Doing good' - using financial resources to meet the needs of disadvantaged people. Judas was keeper of the money bag from which Jesus gave to the poor (John 12:6)

Then Jesus passes the baton to us:

John 14:12

"Very truly I tell you, whoever believes in me will do the works I have been doing, and they will do even greater things than these, because I am going to the Father".

Mark 16:17-18 "And these signs will accompany those who believe: In My name they will drive out demons; they will speak in new tongues; / they will pick up snakes with their hands, and if they drink any deadly poison, it will not harm them; they will lay their hands on the sick, and they will be made well."

John 15:7 "If you remain in Me and My words remain in you, ask whatever you wish, and it will be done for you.

Acts 1:8 "But you will receive power when the Holy Spirit comes upon you, and you will be My witnesses in Jerusalem, and in all Judea and Samaria, and to the ends of the earth." The Holy Spirit is to liberate/release you into action. He ignites or sparks up the boldness in you that pushes you to act now.

Acts 3:6-8 "Peter said, "Silver or gold I do not have, but what I have I give you: In the name of Jesus Christ of Nazareth, get up and walk!" This is spiritual gift.
