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WALKING AMONG THE STONES OF FIRE

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Ezekiel 28:13-14

¹³“You were in Eden, the garden of God. Your clothing was adorned with every precious stone — all beautifully crafted for you and set in the finest gold. They were given to you on the day you were created. ¹⁴I ordained and anointed you as the mighty angelic guardian. You had access to the holy mountain of God and walked among the stones of fire.”

Walking among the stones of fire (walking in Christ’s triumphal procession) keeps our intimate relationship with God and gives us access to His glory. We become guiding light to others, as shown through our words, action and behaviour.

2 Corinthians 2:14-15 “¹⁴ Thanks be to God, who always leads us as captives in Christ’s triumphal procession and uses us to spread the aroma of the knowledge of Him everywhere. ¹⁵ For we are to God the pleasing aroma of Christ among those who are being saved and those who are perishing.”

SERIES PART 20: ENJOYING THE RAIN AND DEW OF THE LORD

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Brethren, people who are walking in Christ's triumphal procession enjoy the rain and dew of the Lord.

Text: Leviticus 26: 3-5

³ “If you follow my decrees and are careful to obey my commands, ⁴ I will send you rain in its season, and the ground will yield its crops and the trees their fruit. ⁵ Your threshing will continue until grape harvest, and the grape harvest will continue until planting, and you shall eat your bread to the full and dwell in your land securely.

Rain yields fruitfulness, wealth and prosperity.

There will never be a time of lack, always a diversity of resources.

- Your threshing will continue until grape harvest
- the grape harvest will continue until planting

No seasonality in your earnings or means of livelihood

Jeremiah. 5:24 says, “It is Lord our God that gives rain.”

Genesis 8:22 “While the earth remains, seedtime and harvest,, shall not cease.”



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Deuteronomy 11:14 “He will give the rain for your land in its season, the early rain and the later rain, that you may gather in **your grain and your wine and your oil**.

We have access to both the early rain and later rains of God and enjoy multiple resources:

Prov. 16:15 confirms that “Favor is a cloud of the latter rain.”

It is, therefore, dangerous to get success in the early rain and then abandon God, which means missing the later rain. Consistency in our work with God is critical.

Zech 10:1 “Ask the Lord for rain in the time of the latter rain.”

Acts 14:17 “He did good by giving you rains from heaven and fruitful seasons”

Therefore, unfruitfulness while doing what God has called us to do is unscriptural, we should not accept it.

Deuteronomy 8:18 says “.... it is God who gives you power to get wealth.”

Proverbs 10:22 “The blessing of the LORD enriches, and He adds no sorrow to it.”



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Unfruitfulness often indicates that something is wrong:

Example:

1 Kings 8, talks about Solomon's prayer of dedication, which says,

³⁵ "When the heavens are shut up and there is no rain because your people have sinned against you, and when they pray toward this place and give praise to your name and turn from their sin because you have afflicted them, ³⁶ then hear from heaven and forgive the sin of your servants, your people Israel. Teach them the right way to live and send rain on the land you gave your people for an inheritance.

Once everything lines up. God's rain comes down to bear fruit.

Ezekiel 34:26 God said "I will send down the showers in their season; they shall be showers of blessing. "

Deuteronomy 28:12 "The LORD will open to you his good treasury, the heavens, to give the rain to your land in its season and to bless all the work of your hands. And you shall lend to many nations, but you shall not borrow.

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Conclusion

Since we are already walking among the stones of fire; in Christ's triumphal procession, we have met the condition for the rain Righteousness. The only thing we now need is to ensure that we are diligent in what we do (work in your hand) because it is the diligent hand that rules (**Proverbs 12:24**).

Deuteronomy 28:8 says “The LORD will decree a blessing on your barns and on everything to which you put your hand; the LORD your God will bless you in the land He is giving you.”

Psalms 133:3 says that when the dew of Hermon (rain) falls on Mount Zion, the LORD bestows His blessing, even life forevermore.

Brethren, let us go and enjoy the rain and dew of God ensuring diligence in the works of our hands.
