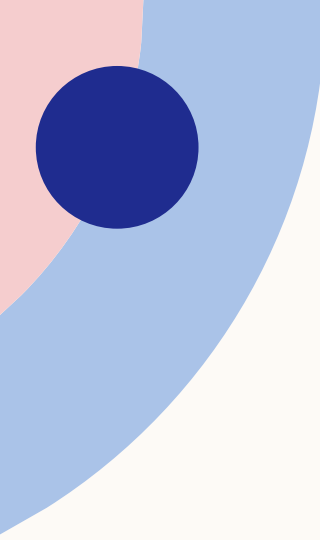

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WALKING AMONG THE STONES OF FIRE

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Ezekiel 28:13-14

¹³“You were in Eden, the garden of God. Your clothing was adorned with every precious stone — all beautifully crafted for you and set in the finest gold. They were given to you on the day you were created. ¹⁴I ordained and anointed you as the mighty angelic guardian. You had access to the holy mountain of God and walked among the stones of fire.”

Walking among the stones of fire (walking in Christ’s triumphal procession) keeps our intimate relationship with God and gives us access to His glory. We become guiding light to others, as shown through our words, action and behaviour.

2 Corinthians 2:14-15 “¹⁴ Thanks be to God, who always leads us as captives in Christ’s triumphal procession and uses us to spread the aroma of the knowledge of Him everywhere. ¹⁵ For we are to God the pleasing aroma of Christ among those who are being saved and those who are perishing.”

Today, we are reminded to lift our prayers with discernment

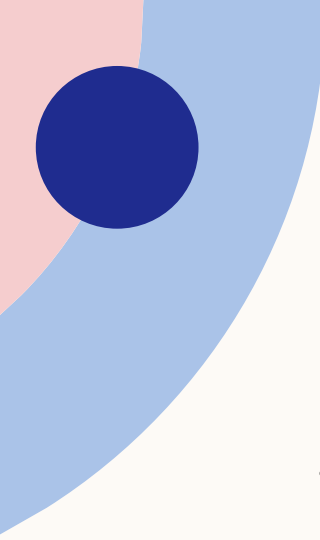
Discernment is a critical part of a Christian’s power.

Discernment is the lubricant of our faith. It gives us insight into what God is saying about a situation. It takes us further away from the natural to tap into the spiritual (the supernatural).

Discernment is ability to get revelation and know what lies behind a situation, word or action. Without discernment, we work or pray with blind spots, which affects our faith.

In John 14:12, Jesus said: – Truly, truly, I say to you, whoever believes in me will also do the works that I do; and greater works than these will he do, because I am going to the Father

..... Jesus thrived in discernment. For us to do greater works, discernment must take centre stage.



Series Part 26: LIFT YOUR PRAYERS WITH DISCERNMENT

1 Corinthians 12: ³¹Now eagerly desire the greater gifts.

We have the privilege of being in Christ's triumphal procession. It is easier for us to eagerly desire the greater gifts.

Discernment increases your sensitivity to a Spiritual Atmosphere.

The natural world and a spiritual world exists concurrently.

People with a gift of discernment have spiritual senses that are attuned to this concurrent situation.

Jesus' Discernment

John 4:16-18 ¹⁶Jesus told the Samaritan Woman, "Go, call your husband and come back." ¹⁷"I have no husband," the woman replied. Jesus said to her, "You are correct to say that you have no husband. ¹⁸In fact, you have had five husbands, and the man you now have is not your husband. You have spoken truthfully."

- Jesus exercised discernment in gaining insights about situations, and with regard to people's motives, attitudes, and even depth of commitment
- Discernment modeled after Jesus is fundamental to building relationships, encouraging new leaders, developing sustainability (of faith, belief, confidence)



Series Part 26: LIFT YOUR PRAYERS WITH DISCERNMENT

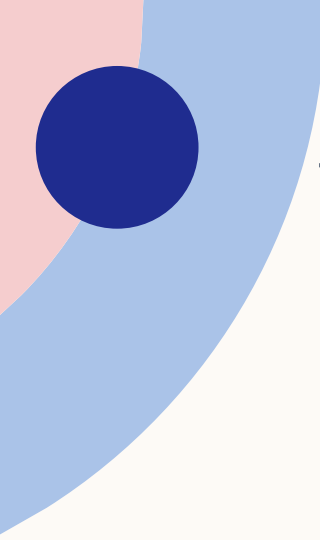
Psalm 119:125, David prayed, “I am your servant; give me discernment.”

Why lift your prayers with discernment?

James 5:16 “The effective, fervent prayer of a righteous man avails much.”

Discernment enables us to make our prayer effective and fervent.

- But solid food is for the mature, for those who have their powers of discernment trained by constant practice to distinguish good from evil. (Hebrews 5:14)
- Natural and supernatural co-exist: The natural person does not accept the things of the Spirit of God, for they are folly to him, and he is not able to understand them because they are spiritually discerned (1 Corinthians 2:14)
 - Without discernment, we operate in the natural
- Discernment is expected from us: And it is my prayer that your love may abound more and more, with knowledge and all discernment. (Philippians 1:9)
- Brethren, let us lift our prayers with discernment.
