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## WALKING AMONG THE STONES OF FIRE


### **Ezekiel 28:13-14**

<sup>13</sup>"You were in Eden, the garden of God. Your clothing was adorned with every precious stone — all beautifully crafted for you and set in the finest gold. They were given to you on the day you were created. <sup>14</sup> I ordained and anointed you as the mighty angelic guardian. You had access to the holy mountain of God and walked among the stones of fire."

Walking among the stones of fire (walking in Christ's triumphal procession) keeps our intimate relationship with God and gives us access to His glory. We become guiding light to others, as shown through our words, action and behaviour.

**2 Corinthians 2:14-15** "<sup>14</sup> Thanks be to God, who always leads us as captives in Christ's triumphal procession and uses us to spread the aroma of the knowledge of Him everywhere. <sup>15</sup> For we are to God the pleasing aroma of Christ among those who are being saved and those who are perishing."

#### **POWERLESS:**

**Zechariah 4:6:** "Not by might nor by power, but by my Spirit,' says the LORD Almighty."

Acts 1:8: "But you will receive power when the Holy Spirit comes upon you,"

Isaiah 40:29-31: "He gives power to the faint and increases the strength of the weak."

**2 Corinthians 12:9: "**"My grace is sufficient for you, for My power is perfected in weakness."

Romans 15:13: "Now may the God of hope fill you with all joy and peace as you believe in Him, so that you may overflow with hope by the power of (in) the Holy Spirit."

1 Corinthians 2:4-5: "My message and my preaching were not with persuasive words of wisdom, but with a demonstration of the Spirit's power, so that your faith would not rest on men's wisdom, but on God's power."

ALERT: (Bible urges believers to "be alert," "be watchful," and "stay awake")

John 15:5: "I am the vine, and you are the branches. The one who remains in Me, and I in him, will bear much fruit."

**Isaiah 41:10:** "Do not fear, for I am with you; do not be afraid, for I am your God. I will strengthen you; I will surely help you; I will uphold you ..."

**Eph. 6:8:** "Pray in the Spirit on all occasions with all kinds of prayers and requests; Be alert." **Luke 12:35-37:** "Be dressed for service and keep your lamps burning."

Matthew 24:42: "Keep watch, because you do not know on what day your Lord will come."

Eph. 2:10: "For we are God's handiwork, created in Christ Jesus to do good works"

**Eph. 5:15-16:** "Be very careful, then, how you live—not as unwise but as wise, making the most of every opportunity." .... **Don't leave any food on the table.** 

1 Corin. 16:13: "Be on your guard; stand firm in the faith; be courageous; be strong."

1 Peter 1:13: "Prepare your minds for action, and being sober-minded, set your hope fully on the grace that will be brought to you at the revelation of Jesus Christ."

**Examples: Powerless BUT Alert.** 

Gideon and David......

Brethren, there is a geometric pattern, the Art (relationship) that drives our faith.

#### 1. Gideon

Judges 6: <sup>1</sup>"The Israelites did evil in the eyes of the LORD, and for seven years he gave them into the hands of the Midianites. <sup>2</sup> the power of Midian was so oppressive,.... <sup>11</sup> The angel of the LORD came and sat down under the oak in Ophrah that belonged to Joash the Abiezrite, where his son Gideon was threshing wheat in a winepress to keep it from the Midianites. <sup>12</sup> When the angel of the LORD appeared to Gideon, he said, "The LORD is with you, mighty warrior." <sup>13</sup> "Pardon me, my lord," Gideon replied, "but if the LORD is with us, why has all this happened to us? **Powerless but Gideon was alert and God showed up.** 

Judges 7, Gideon defeated the Midianites with only 300 army.

#### 2. David

**1 Samuel 17:** <sup>43</sup> Goliath said to David, "Am I a dog, that you come at me with sticks?" And the Philistine cursed David by his gods. <sup>44</sup> "Come here," he said, "and I'll give

your flesh to the birds and the wild animals!" <sup>45</sup> David said to the Philistine, "You come against me with sword and spear and javelin, but I come against you in the name of the LORD Almighty, the God of the armies of Israel, whom you have defied. <sup>46</sup> This day the LORD will deliver you into my hands."... <sup>47</sup> All those gathered here will know that it is not by sword or spear that the LORD saves; for the battle is the LORD's, and he will give all of you into our hands."

#### Brethren, we have a Geometric relationship.

**2 Corinthians 10:4: 3**For though we live in the flesh, we do not wage war according to the flesh. **4** The weapons of our warfare are not the weapons of the world. Instead, but mighty in God (they have divine power) to demolish strongholds.

#### David on his own was powerless BUT very alert.

<sup>48</sup> As the Philistine moved closer to attack him, David ran quickly toward the battle line to meet him. <sup>49</sup> Reaching into his bag and taking out a stone, he slung it and struck the Philistine on the forehead. The stone sank into his forehead, and he fell facedown on the ground.

Geometric relationship requires that we follow the heavenly structure. Joining the triangle of the trinity as branches on the vine (Christ) and the dwelling place of the Holy Spirit.

**1 John 5:11:** "And this is the testimony: God has given us eternal life, and this life is in his Son."

Luke 12:11-12: "<sup>11</sup>do not worry about how to defend yourselves or what to say. <sup>12</sup>For at that time the Holy Spirit will teach you what you should say."

Brethren, our hallmark is POWERLESS BUT ALERT, riding on our geometric relationship with the trinity.
