# You Are A Brand-new Person: Lay Aside Weights that Hinder Purpose

**Part 1** reminds us that those who trust in the LORD will renew their strength; they will soar on wings like eagles; they will run and not become weary, they will walk and not faint (Isaiah 40:31).

**Part 2 cautions us to Lay Aside Weights that Hinder Purpose.** We need to shed weights to soar high; weights press us down but to soar for purpose, we need to lift ourselves up.

**As Hebrews 12:1 commands,** “Let us strip off every weight that slows us down, especially the sin that so easily trips us up. And let us run with endurance the race God has set before us (which is our purpose).



**Brethren,** as Hebrews 12:1 shows, there are two kinds of weights: Sin and Non-sin. We don't even want to talk about Sin-weights at all, because:

1. The soul that sins will die (Ezekiel 18:20) - we are personally accountable.
2. Let no sin be heard among you (Ephs. 5:3), is a call for high moral standard.

... Our focus is on the Non-Sin weights that hinder purpose.

**Remove everything that stops you from running with purpose.**

**1.** For eagles, it is their old feathers and blunt peak, so they pluck them off. In Isaiah 40:31, God likens us to the eagle. God expects us to shed the old feathers and pluck off the blunt peak so we can soar for our purpose.

**2.** As Jesus says, non-sin weights can be as simple as turning one's eyes away from one's purpose. **“No one who puts a hand to the plow and looks back is fit for service in the kingdom of God” (Luke 9:62).**



**3.** In the story of Mary and Martha (Luke 10:38-42), non-sin weights could be as simple as excessive house chores and focusing on irrelevant routines that draw you away from purpose.

**Luke 10:** <sup>38</sup> Jesus entered a certain village where a woman named Martha welcomed him. <sup>39</sup> She had a sister named Mary, who sat at Jesus' feet and

listened to what Jesus was saying. <sup>40</sup> **But Martha was distracted by her many tasks**, so she came to Jesus and asked, “Lord, do you not care that my sister has left me to do all the work by myself? Tell her, then, to help me.” <sup>41</sup> But the Lord answered her, “Martha, Martha, you are worried and distracted by many things, <sup>42</sup> but few things are needed—indeed only one Mary has chosen the better part, which will not be taken away from her.”

**Brethren**, when we are bogged down by too many tasks, we will not have the band-width to focus on what is important for achieving our purpose.



And achieving purpose is critical.

Jesus said, “My food is to do the will of him who sent me and to finish his work.” John 4:34. Pursing the purpose is key.

Jesus said that distraction from too many tasks does not lead to purpose.

**Matha's name faded away very quickly.**

**But by focusing on only what is important, Mary got the vision of Jesus' purpose, which she then pursued with vigor:**

a. She cleaned His feet with her hair, why?

b. She poured expensive perfume on His feet, why?

c. <sup>32</sup> When Mary reached the place where Jesus was and saw Him, she fell at his feet and said, "Lord, if you had been here, my brother would not have died."

**Brethren**, the only thing that changed Mary's story is focus on purpose.

Let's put away the house chores, the unnecessary things and focus on purpose. Certain house chores is the purpose for certain people, stay on yours and allow them to do theirs.

Therefore, **Lay Aside Weights that Hinder Purpose.**
