You Are A Brand-new Person: Part 4: Pursue **IT** with Unwavering Confidence

Part 1 “Brand-new like Eagle” reminds us that those who trust in the LORD renew their strength; soar on new wings like eagles; run and not weary, walk and not faint (Isaiah 40:31).

Part 2 “Lay Aside Weights that Hinder Purpose” – we need to shed weights to soar high; weights press us down and hinder purpose.

Part 3 “Immerse in Oil of Joy & Fountain of Life” – Focus on God’s restoration; don’t let your love grow cold because of what you feel (or see around you).

Part 4 “Pursue **IT with Unwavering Confidence”** - *Rooted in God, Steady in Life*. Authentic belief in your abilities and worth. Built through self-awareness and Purpose, consistent self-trust, and taking action despite fear, failure, criticism or uncertainty.

Definitions:

Pursue **IT:** whatever is the God-given “**IT**” in your life.

“Therefore, do not be foolish, but understand what the Lord's will is.” (Eph 5:17)

Unwavering confidence—a quiet, authentic belief in your abilities and worth that persists despite fear, failure, criticism or uncertainty—confidence not rooted in ego, but trust in God’s character, calling, presence, purpose.

Brethren, before you can trust your abilities, you must trust your identity.

David Said “I praise You because I am fearfully and wonderfully made.” — Psalm 139:14

God said "Let us make man in our image, after our likeness"— Genesis 1:26

(Establishing humanity as unique creations designed to reflect God's character)

Even in science, before you can trust your abilities, you complete a self-awareness assessment.

You are not random. You are intentional. Designed. Known. Formed with purpose.

 Treat yourself with intentionality. Make every step you take deliberate. Make each minute count as important (**Ephesians 5:16**)

Unwavering Confidence has Characteristics:

1. Confidence Rooted in Identity (Self-Worth)

“For I know the plans I have for you... plans to give you hope and a future.” — Jeremiah 29:11

Confidence grows when you believe your life (or future) is intentional, not accidental. It is authored. Self-awareness means recognizing you are intentionally designed by God.

Unless you choose truncate it by turning away from God, no human can truncate it.

2. Confidence Persists Despite Fear, Failure or Criticism

True confidence does not mean absence of **Failure or Criticism** —it means moving forward regardless of it.

“So do not fear, for I am with you... I will strengthen you and help you...” (Isaiah 41:10)

“For God has not given us a spirit of fear, but of power, love, and a sound mind.” (2 Timothy 1:7)

Unwavering confidence is sustained by the assurance of God’s presence.

3. Confidence Proven Through Action Despite Uncertainty

Confidence deepens when you act in faith.

“Faith by itself, if it is not accompanied by action, is dead.” (**James 2:17**)

“The LORD directs the steps of the godly. He delights in every detail of their lives. (**Psalms 37:23**)

Taking action builds self-trust and invites God to direct you. TRUST! You don’t need full clarity.



4. Confidence that Triumphs

“I can do all things through Christ who strengthens me.” (**Philippians 4:13**)

“So do not throw away your confidence; it will be richly rewarded.” (**Heb 10:35**)

“All things work together for good, for those who are called according to His purpose” (**Romans 8:28**)

5. Confidence is Quiet and Authentic (Not Arrogance)

“Not that we are competent in ourselves... but our competence comes from God.” (2 Cor 3:5)

“It is not by your might nor by power, but by my Spirit, says the Lord”(Zechariah 4:6)

“Yes, even the spirits obey you. And you can be happy, not because you have this power, but because your names are written in heaven.” (Luke 10:20)

Humble because it recognizes the true source of strength is God.

Summary: unwavering confidence is:

- Rooted in identity
- Confidence Persists Despite Fear, Failure or Criticism
- Confidence Proven through faith-based action in uncertainties
- Confidence that Triumphs
- Confidence is Quiet and Authentic (Not Arrogance)

We can have biblical examples: Jesus and David

Luke 2:40-52 - At age 12, Jesus remained in the Jerusalem Temple for three days after Passover, causing Mary and Joseph to search for him anxiously. They found him sitting among teachers, listening and asking questions, displaying advanced understanding. Jesus told them: "Why were you searching for me?" he asked. "Didn't you know I had to be in my Father's house?"

Hebrews 12:2 – "We do this by keeping our eyes on Jesus, the author and finisher of *our* faith, who for the joy that was set before Him endured the cross, despising the shame, and has sat down at the right hand of the throne of God."

Despising the shame meant treating the mockery, humiliation, criticisms and agony as insignificant compared to the glory and joy of his accomplished mission.



David: **(1 Samuel 17:37)** - "I killed the lion and the bear. The Lord who rescued/delivered me from the paw of the lion and from the paw of the bear. He will rescue/deliver me from the hand of this Philistine".
David said: (1 Samuel 17:26) "who is this uncircumcised Philistine, that he should defy the armies of the living God?" - **Unwavering Confidence**
