You Are A Brand-new Person: Part 5: AS WHITE AS SNOW

Part 1 “Brand-new like Eagle” reminds us that those who trust in the LORD renew their strength; soar on new wings like eagles; run and not weary, walk and not faint (Isaiah 40:31).

Part 2 “Lay Aside Weights that Hinder Purpose” – we need to shed weights to soar high; weights press us down and hinder purpose.

Part 3 “Immerse in Oil of Joy & Fountain of Life” – Focus on God’s restoration; don’t let your love grow cold because of what you feel (or see around you).

Part 4 “Pursue **IT with Unwavering Confidence” - *Rooted in God, Steady in Life*.** Authentic belief in your abilities and worth. Built through self-awareness and Purpose, consistent self-trust, and taking action despite fear, failure, criticism or uncertainty.

Part 5 “As White As Snow” - Test/examine yourselves. Find something that makes you go a step deeper with God and do it. Keep going until you encounter that turning point. If you are willing and obedient, you will eat the best of the land.

AS WHITE AS SNOW:

1 Corinthians 3:16: “Do you not know that you yourselves are God’s temple.?”

2 Corinthians 13:5: “Examine yourselves to see whether you are in the faith; test yourselves.”

1 Corinthians 3:16-17

¹⁶Do you not know that you yourselves are God's temple, and that God's Spirit dwells in you? ¹⁷If anyone destroys God's temple, God will destroy him; for God's temple is holy, and you are that temple.

2 Corinthians 13:5

⁵Examine yourselves to see whether you are in the faith; test yourselves. Do you not realize that Christ Jesus is in you—unless, of course, you fail the test?

The Implication

- "If anyone *is* in Christ, *he is* a new creation. The old things have passed away; behold, *the* new has come into being." (2 Corinthians 5:17)
- Your pathways is different from others'. Stay focused.



You Are A Brand-new Person: Part 5: AS WHITE AS SNOW

Example: Moses (Exodus 3)

- 40 years in Pharaoh's palace as an adopted son
- Loved his people (Hebrews), killed an Egyptian, became a fugitive
- Marries a Priest's child, became Herdsman for 40 years, tending flocks in the bush
- 40 years doing same thing as other herdsman – “taking flocks to familiar territory”
- One day, he tests/examines himself, decides to go out of normal, to very far away
- That day became a turning point; he encounters God in the burning bush, his story changed.

Exodus 3: ⁵ “Do not come any closer,” God said. “Take off your sandals, for the place where you are standing is holy ground.” ⁶ Then God said, “I am the God of your father, the God of Abraham, the God of Isaac and the God of Jacob.”

At this, Moses hid his face, because he was afraid to look at God.

Brethren, let's test/examine ourselves. Find something that makes you go a step deeper with God and do it. That thing could become a turning point. Keep going until you get to that one that becomes the turning point.
