# You Are A Brand-new Person: Part 6: Unquestionable He is the Great God

**Part 1 “Brand-new like Eagle”** reminds us that those who trust in the LORD renew their strength; soar on new wings like eagles; run and not weary, walk and not faint (Isaiah 40:31).

**Part 2 “Lay Aside Weights that Hinder Purpose”** – we need to shed weights to soar high; weights press us down and hinder purpose.

**Part 3 “Immerse in Oil of Joy & Fountain of Life”** – Focus on God’s restoration; don’t let your love grow cold because of what you feel (or see around you).

**Part 4 “Pursue **IT** with Unwavering Confidence” - *Rooted in God, Steady in Life*.** Authentic belief in your abilities and worth. Built through self-awareness and Purpose, consistent self-trust, and taking action despite fear, failure, criticism or uncertainty.

**Part 5 “As White As Snow”** - Test/examine yourselves. Find something that makes you go a step deeper with God and do it. Keep going until you encounter that turning point. If you are willing and obedient, you will eat the best of the land.

**Part 6 “Unquestionable He is the Great God”** – At a stage in one’s life, God decides to make the person a brand new person, Then, He goes ahead to show Himself mighty on that person.



**Context: Unquestionable He is the Great God.**

“Blessed is He that believes for there shall be a performance of that which he/she believes –” (**Luke 1:45**) “Let it be on to you according to your faith” (Math 9:29)

# You Are A Brand-new Person: Part 6: Unquestionable He is the Great God

1. **Aman who has been blind for a very long time**, at a stage in his life, God decides to make him a brand-new person, and he gets his sight and begins to see:

## **Matthew 9:27-30**

<sup>27</sup> As Jesus went on from there, two blind men followed him, calling out, "Have mercy on us, Son of David!" <sup>28</sup> When he had gone indoors, the blind men came to him, and he asked them, "Do you believe that I am able to do this?"

"Yes, Lord," they replied. <sup>29</sup> Then he touched their eyes and said, "According to your faith let it be done to you"; <sup>30</sup> and their sight was restored.

**Principle:** a. You must follow Jesus, b. You must ask, c. Ask for mercy/forgiveness (just incase), d. You must believe, e. You received because He touched you, so give glory back to Him

2. **Hardship persists for a very long time**, you want to run away, but God says, **NO**, stay there I will bless you. – Then He makes you a brand new person - blesses you plenty even in time of famine/hardship.

Example in **Genesis 26:1-14**

<sup>1</sup> Now there was a famine in the land— —and Isaac went to Abimelek king of the Philistines in Gerar. <sup>2</sup> The LORD appeared to Isaac and said, "Do not go down to Egypt; live in the land where I tell you to live. <sup>3</sup> Stay in this land for a

while, and I will be with you and will bless you. (*God wants to make Isaac a brand-new person*) \_\_\_\_\_

<sup>12</sup> Isaac planted crops in that land, and the same year reaped a hundredfold, because the LORD blessed him. <sup>13</sup> The man became rich, and his wealth continued to grow until he became very wealthy. <sup>14</sup> He had so many flocks and herds and servants that the Philistines envied him.

**Principle:** Isaac listened to God, heard God and obeyed God.

**3. Life seems normal.** You are working very diligently and following God very personally and meticulously. One day God decides to lift you higher . Totally unexpected, He makes you a brand new person, and your life is changed forever.

**Example David, 1 Samuel 16:1, 11-13**

<sup>1</sup>The LORD said to Samuel, ---- “Fill your horn with oil and be on your way; I am sending you to Jesse of Bethlehem. I have chosen one of his sons to be king.” (*David was not expecting this, totally God’s own decision to make him a brand-new person*)

**But** David was working very diligently and following God very personally and meticulously:

- David tending his father’s flocks in the wilderness (**1 Samuel 16:17**)
- **Acts 13:22**, God testified about David: ‘I have found David son of Jesse a

‘---- man after My own heart; he will carry out My will in its entirety.’ (David personally and meticulously followed God)

<sup>11</sup>Samuel said, “Send for him; we will not sit down until he arrives.”

<sup>12</sup> So he sent for him and had him brought in. ...Then the LORD said, “Rise and anoint him; this is the one.” <sup>13</sup> So Samuel took the horn of oil and anointed him in the presence of his brothers, **and from that day on the Spirit of the LORD came powerfully upon David.**

**Principle:** Working with God personally and meticulously, God gave David a brand-new life.

## Conclusion:

**Brethren,** I don’t know what your story is or what category you belong:

- Need healing from God (like the blind men)
- There is time of famine/hardship (like Isaac)
- Life seems normal, you are diligent at what you do, and serving God personally and meticulously (like David),

**Unquestionable, He is the Great God.** He decides to make you a brand-new person, He shows Himself mighty on your behalf and changes your story forever. (2 Chronicles 16:9)
