## Part 16: You Are More Than Conquerors

**Romans 8:31-39** – Assurance that we are more than conquerors

**Daniel 5:1-30** – Qualities of someone who is more than Conquerors

**Today's study is particularly important because, God says:**

<sup>1</sup>Men ought to regard us as servants of Christ and stewards of the mysteries of God. <sup>2</sup>Now it is required of stewards that they be found faithful. <sup>3</sup>I care very little, however, if I am judged by you or by any human court. In fact, I do not even judge myself. (1 Corinthians 4: 1-3).

**Brethren**, the mystery is that we as ordinary people are made more than Conquerors. Since we are stewards of this mystery of God, it is required of us to be found faithful. Daniel demonstrates to us how to be faithful as stewards of God mystery.

**Romans 8:31-39**

<sup>31</sup> What, then, shall we say in response to these things? If God is for us, who can be against us?

<sup>33</sup> Who will bring any charge against those whom God has chosen? It is God who justifies....

<sup>36</sup> As it is written: "For your sake we face death all day long; we are considered as sheep to be slaughtered." <sup>37</sup> No, **in all these things we are more than conquerors through him who loved us.**



## Part 16: You Are More Than Conquerors

### Daniel 5:1-30 - Daniel exemplifies three things for us:

- what mysteries look like
- how men ought to regard us as servants of Christ and stewards of the mysteries of God
- how to be faithful as stewards of the mysteries

### #1: what mysteries look like: Example: The Writing on the Wall

<sup>2</sup> While Belshazzar was drinking his wine, he gave orders to bring in the gold and silver goblets that Nebuchadnezzar his father had taken from the temple in Jerusalem, so that the king and his nobles, his wives and his concubines might drink from them. So, ... (they) drank from them.

<sup>4</sup> As they drank the wine, they praised the gods of gold and silver, of bronze, iron, wood and stone. <sup>5</sup> Suddenly the fingers of a human hand appeared and wrote on the plaster of the wall, near the lampstand in the royal palace. The king watched the hand as it wrote. <sup>6</sup> His face turned pale and he was so frightened that his legs became weak and his knees were knocking.

<sup>7</sup> The king summoned the enchanters, astrologers and diviners. Then he said to these wise men of Babylon, "Whoever reads this writing and tells me what it means will be clothed in purple and have a gold chain placed around his neck, and he will be made the third highest ruler in the kingdom."

***..... the king hereby summoned the Conquerors, wise men of Babylon***



## Part 16: You Are More Than Conquerors

### #2: how men ought to regard us as servants of Christ and stewards of the mysteries of God

<sup>8</sup> Then all the king's wise men came in, but they could not read the writing or tell the king what it meant. <sup>9</sup> So King Belshazzar became even more terrified, and his face grew more pale. His nobles were baffled.

<sup>10</sup> The queen hearing the voices of the king and his nobles, came into the banquet hall.

<sup>11</sup> There is a man in your kingdom who has the spirit of the holy gods in him. (***brethren, we must have the Spirit of God very active in us***). In the time of your father he was found to have insight and intelligence and wisdom like that of the gods. Your father, ... appointed him chief of the magicians, enchanters, astrologers and diviners (***Because of the Holy Spirit in Daniel, he had superior qualities than Conquerors***). <sup>12</sup> He did this because Daniel, ... was found to have a keen mind and knowledge and understanding, ...the ability to interpret dreams, explain riddles and solve difficult problems. **Call for Daniel, and he will tell you what the writing means."**

### #3: how to be faithful as stewards of the mysteries

<sup>13</sup> So Daniel was brought before the king, and the king said to him....<sup>16</sup>... If you can read this writing and tell me what it means, you will be clothed in purple and have a gold chain placed around your neck, and you will be made the third highest ruler in the kingdom." <sup>17</sup> Then Daniel answered the king,



## Part 16: You Are More Than Conquerors

“You may keep your gifts for yourself and give your rewards to someone else. Nevertheless, I will read the writing for the king and tell him what it means.

**Brethren**, that is how to be faithful stewards of God’s mystery. We should not be interested in the gifts and acclamations of men when we are demonstrating God’s powers.

In **John 5:41**, Jesus said ““I do not accept glory from human beings”

**Daniel 5:1-30**,<sup>22</sup> “But you, Belshazzar, ..have not humbled yourself, ...<sup>23</sup> Instead, you have set yourself up against the Lord of heaven. You had the goblets from his temple brought to you, and you and your nobles, ....drank wine from them. You praised the gods of silver and gold, ... which cannot see or hear or understand. But you did not honor the God who holds in His hand your life and all your ways. <sup>24</sup> Therefore He sent the hand that wrote the inscription.

...<sup>28</sup>... Your kingdom is divided and given to the Medes and Persians.”...<sup>30</sup> That very night Belshazzar, king of the Babylonians, was slain,<sup>31</sup> and Darius the Mede took over the kingdom, at the age of sixty-two.

**Brethren**, You Are More Than Conquerors. With humility, let us continue to enjoy the goodness of the Lord in the land of the living.
